

## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds out of the N/NNW will continue to gradually decrease throughout the afternoon. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 10-15 kts are expected to continue until 6 PM-CT, then, sustained winds will decrease to 4 - 9 kts through the rest of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will continue at 15-20 kts through 6 PM-CT (winds at the Boarding Station closer to 25 kts). After 6 PM-CT, winds will drop to 7 -12 kts for the rest of the evening (winds at the Boarding Station at 15-20 kts for the evening. Locations south of Morgan's Point are at risk of up to 23-28 kts while the strongest of gusts can occur at 11/12 and the Boarding Station of ~30 kts through 5 PM. After 5 PM, gusts S of Morgan's Point will decrease to 18-23 kts for the rest of the evening.

Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 40s F S of Morgan's Point: Low to near 50 F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns.

## **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Anticipating dry conditions for Tuesday.

Wind: Winds out of the N/NNE will become variable after 12 PM. Winds settle out of the SE by 8 PM. N Morgan's Point: 3 - 8 kts sustained. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7-12 kts will gradually decrease through the AM, calming to 3-8 kts after 12 PM.






**Precip:** Dry conditions favored for Wednesday.








**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 




## **8-14** Day Temperature Departure
