


Precip: Anticipating dry conditions for today.

Wind: Winds out of the N/NNE will become variable after 12 PM. Winds settle out of the SE by 9 PM. N Morgan's Point: 3 - 8 kts sustained. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 8-13 kts will gradually decrease through the AM, calming to 3-8 kts after 10 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid-Upper 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 50s - Lower 60s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns for Tuesday.


Precip: Dry conditions favored for Wednesday.

Wind: Winds out of the SE throughout Wednesday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3-8 kts through 11 AM, increasing to 7-12 kts after that time. S of Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts through 8 AM, increasing to 10-15 kts after that time. Winds near the Boarding Station can be slightly elevated at 15-18 kts after 7 PM. Gusts of 20-25 kts will be possible at all stations after 11 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70 F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid-Low 60s F

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions through ~6 AM before light hit/miss activity works into the area through 6 PM. Dry conditions favored afterwards.

Wind: Winds out of the S/SE will transition to being out of the S by 7 AM on THU. N Morgan's Point: Winds decrease to 3-8 kts by 5 AM and remain there through 1 PM. Winds then increase to 9-14 kts through 8 PM before decreasing to 4-9 kts the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds decrease to 9-14 kts by 6 AM and continue there the rest of the day. Gusts of 20-25 kts will be possible at all stations through 6 AM and N of Morgan's Point again from 12-5 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.


Visibility: A low end risk for patchy fog throughout the day mixed in with rain showers. Will have the ability to create reduced visibilities of 2-4 miles

Wind Speed: 4 PM CT








Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure
