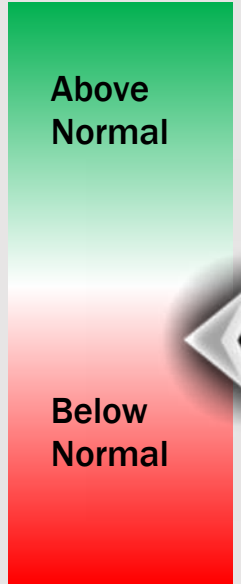

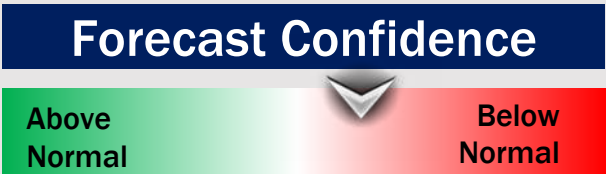
- Anticipating hazy conditions to begin to develop after 5 PM-CT today reducing visibility to 2 – 4 miles.
- Throughout the evening this "haze" will grow in coverage, transitioning into a patchy dense fog by 10 PM-CT Friday, primarily for stations S of Morgan's Point.
- By 12 AM-CT Saturday, patchy dense fog will now have extended N. of Morgan's Point, possibly causing all stations to be impacted with visibilities down to less than 1 mile. **Coverage will be most widespread and dense between 4 AM- 9 AM-CT Sat with visibility of less than 0.5 mile.**
- Fog will begin to gradually lift after 9- 10 AM, improving visibility to 1 – 3 miles for most stations (risk of less than 1 mile will remain for stations 51/52 through the Boarding Station).
- Anticipating this fog does not clear out completely until ~3 PM-CT Sat.

Forecast Discussion

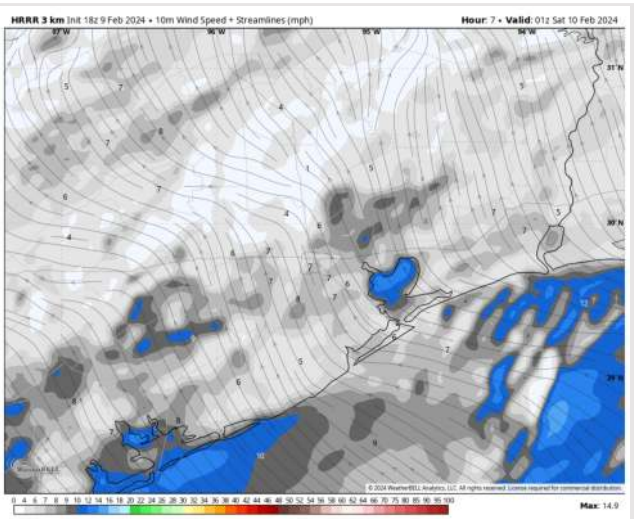
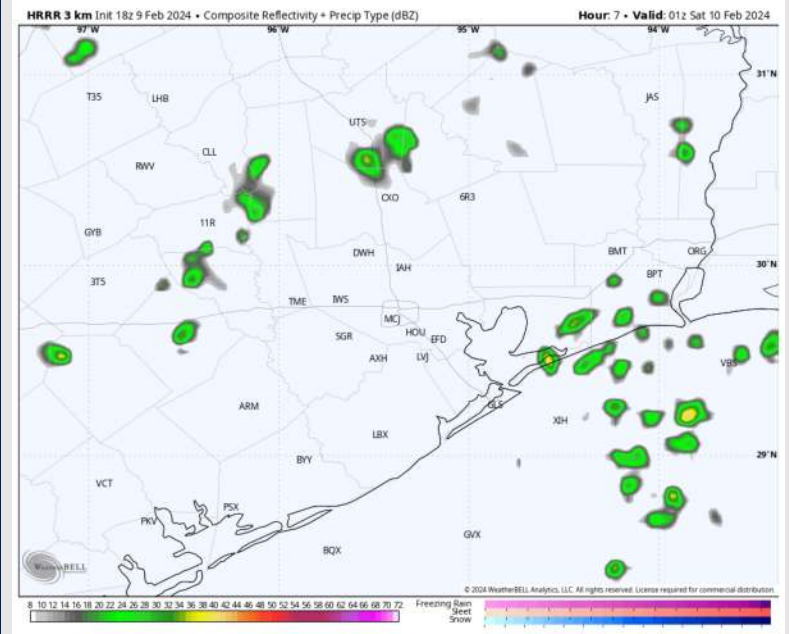
Precip: Light, scattered showers and drizzle will continue to be possible (40%) for the remainder of the day. There is potential for light/moderate showers after 4PM.

Wind: Winds will remain out of the S / SE. **N Morgan's Point:** Winds will sit at 10 - 15 kts through 6 PM-CT before gradually decreasing to 3 - 8 kts for the rest of the day. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds at 5 - 10 kts for the remainder of the evening. **Gusts of 18-20 kts will be possible for all stations for the rest of the day.**

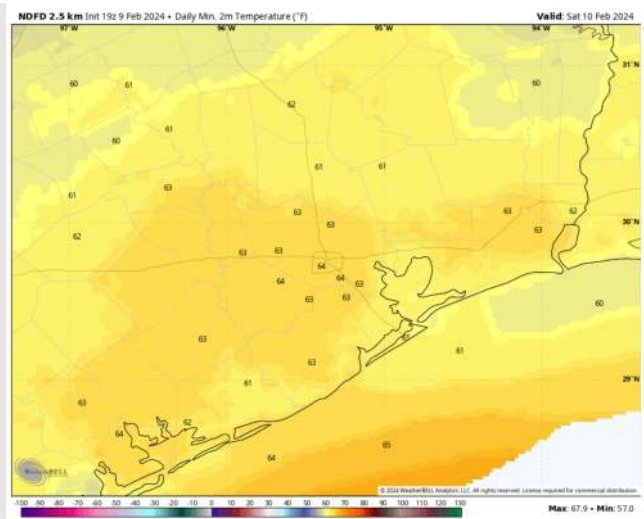
Low Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Mid to low 60s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Low to near 60 F.

Visibility: Hazy conditions expected to build back in this afternoon / evening with the patchy dense fog risk increasing nearing the midnight timeframe. **See visibility slide for more details.**

Forecast Discussion

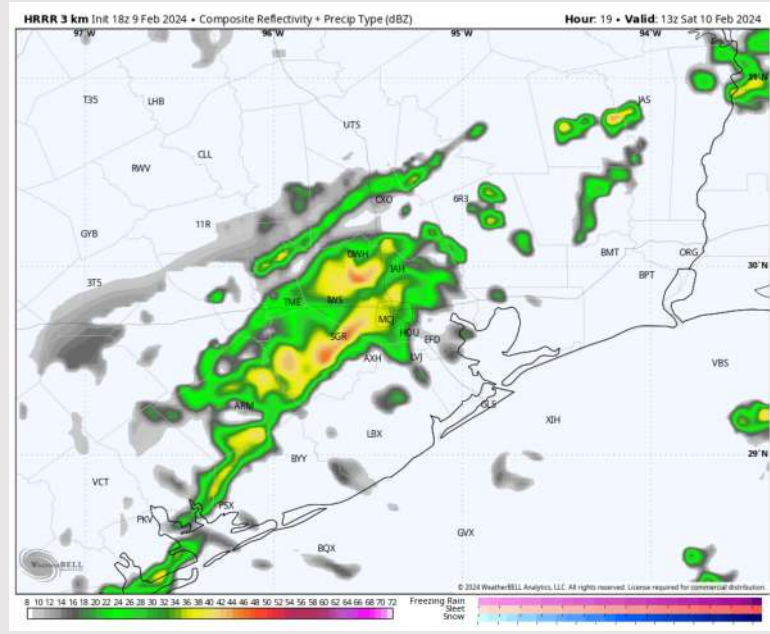
Precip: Light to moderate rain risks will be ongoing during the morning hours (60%), especially N of Morgan's Point, with shower coverage gradually decreasing after 11AM. A few rumbles of thunder cannot be ruled out. From 11 AM through the rest of the PM, there will be a 10% chance of showers at all stations.

Wind: Winds will start out and remain southerly before becoming southwesterly after 8PM. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds will start at 7 – 10 kts before increasing to 9 – 13 kts after 10AM. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds will remain at 13 – 17 kts for the entire day. **Gusts of 18 - 23 kts will be possible at all stations after 8AM.**

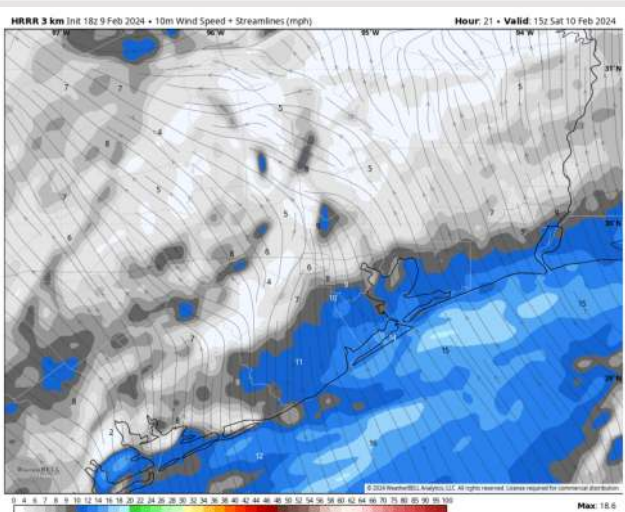
High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 70 F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid 60s F

Visibility: Patchy to widespread sea fog will be a risk throughout the AM. **See visibility slide for more details.**

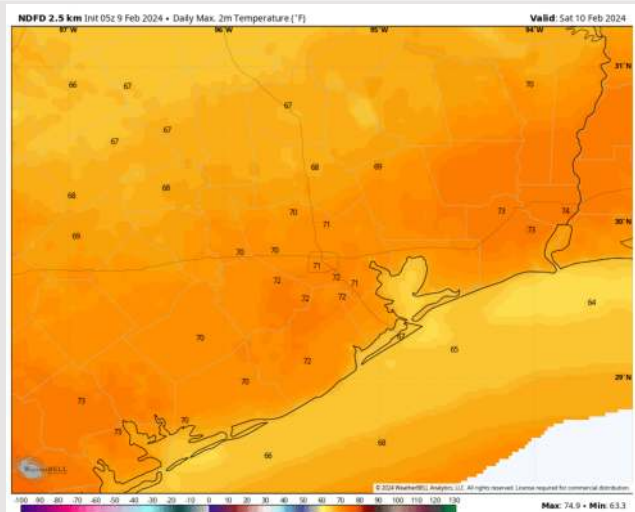
Precip Image: 7 AM CT

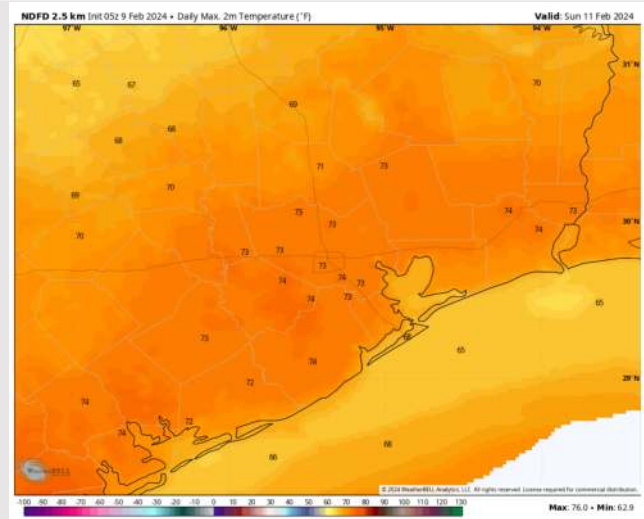
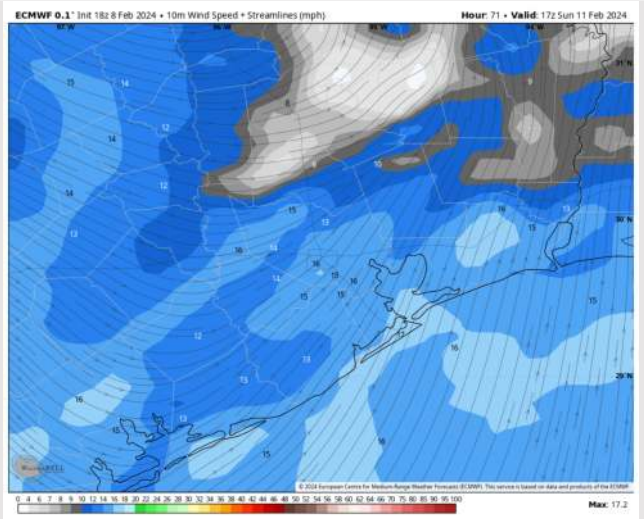
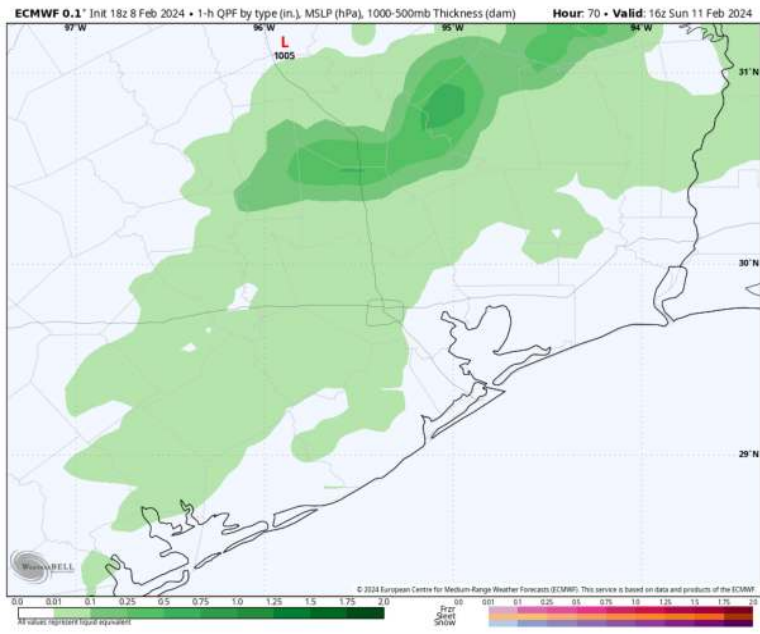
Precip: Favoring light hit/miss drizzle (10% to hang around through ~10 AM. Chances will then increase after 10 PM as scattered moderate to heavy showers enter from the NW in association with a passing front. These scattered showers will linger through 3 PM.

Wind: Winds out of the SSE will veer out of the NE by 2 PM. **N Morgan's Point:** Winds will be at 3-8 kts until 8 AM-CT before increasing to 7-12 kts for the remainder of the day. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds at 3-8 kts will gradually increase to 10-15 kts by 9 AM, remaining at that speed throughout the day. **Wind gusts of 25-30 kts possible for all stations after 10 AM.**

High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Mid 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid 60s.

Visibility: As a front passes through SUN AM, moderate to at times heavy rain will be able to create reduced visibilities along with patchy fog mixed in towards the coast.

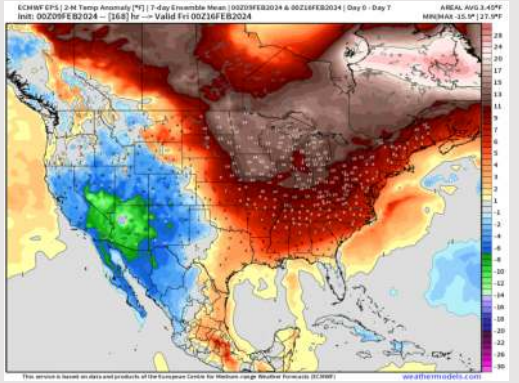

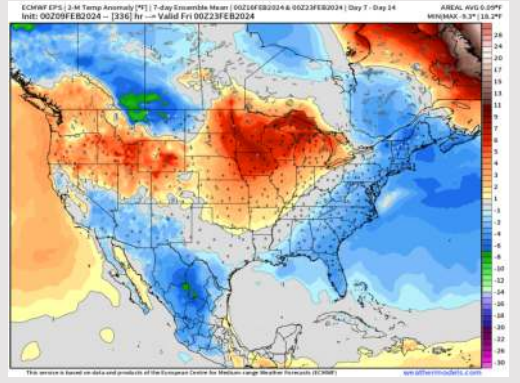

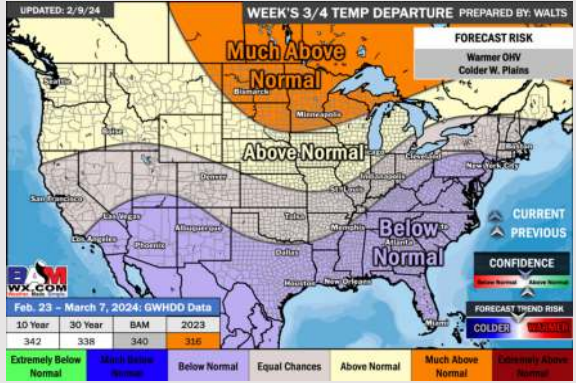
Next 7 Day Temperature Departure



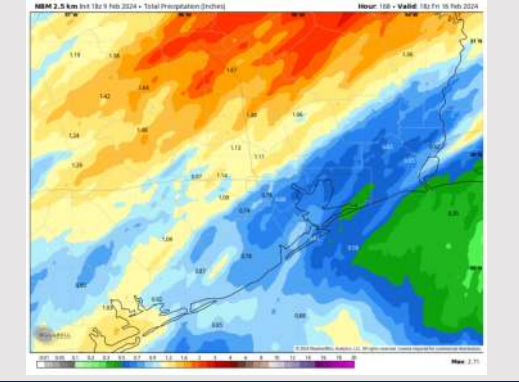
8-14 Day Temperature Departure



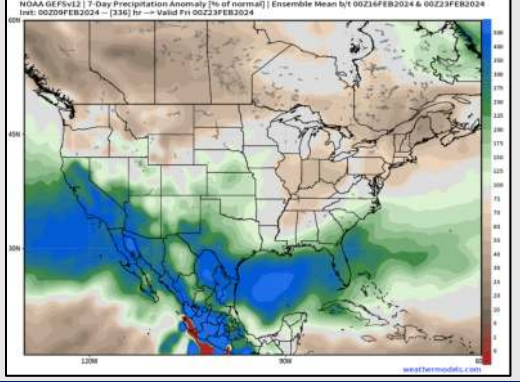
15-30 Day Temperature Departure



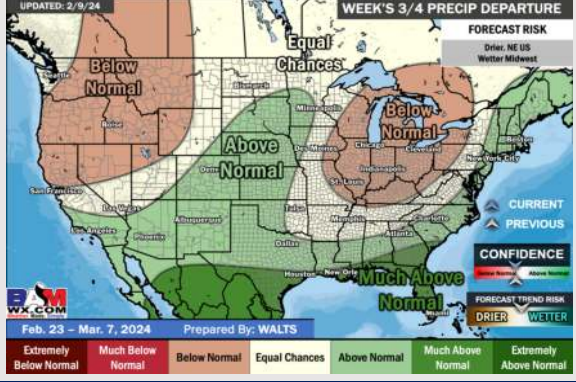
Next 7 Day Total Precipitation

- A weak front is pressing through today bringing light scattered rain. Following this front will be a more active weekend. Above normal temperatures favored for the week ahead.
- Slightly above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps expected to be seasonable to just below normal.
- Below normal temperatures and much above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks 3/4 timeframe.
