

- ➤ Stations South of Morgan's Point will now need to watch for locally dense fog less than 1 mi in visibility. Lower confidence exists on the final exit time of sea fog as patchy coverage does run the risk of lingering through sunrise tomorrow.
- ➤ Just after midnight, it is possible that Morgan's Point, Exxon 3 and Lynchburg Ferries can see additional patchy fog/mist form in and last through ~5-6 AM, reducing visibilities to 3-5 miles.
- ➤ It is likely coverage remains widespread through sunrise for locations South of Morgan's Point. Visibility can be two miles or less throughout the early AM hours.
- ➤ There will be a cold front sweeping through from about 12 4 PM and it would depend on the timing of this front to completely wipe out fog chances. This 4-hour window for now would be when fog chances can potentially end into the early afternoon.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Through the rest of the PM, there will be a 10% chance of showers at all stations. Heavier precip chances likely to remain North of all Stations.

Wind: Winds out of the S become southwesterly after 8PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 9 – 13 kts through 6 PM, at which time winds will decrease to 3-8 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will remain at 13 – 17 kts through 6 PM, decreasing to 4-9 kts after that time. Gusts of 18 - 23 kts remain in play for all stations through 6 PM.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring light hit/miss drizzle (10% to hang around through ~10 AM. Chances will then increase after 10 AM as scattered moderate to heavy showers enter from the NW in association with a passing front. These scattered showers will linger through 3 PM.

Wind: Winds out of the SSE will veer out of the NE by 2 PM. N Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3-8 kts until 8 AM-CT before increasing to 7-12 kts for the remainder of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3-8 kts will gradually increase to 10-15 kts by 9 AM, remaining at that speed throughout the day. Wind gusts of 25-30 kts possible for all stations after 10 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s.

Visibility: As a front passes through SUN AM, moderate to at times heavy rain will be able to create reduced visibilities along with patchy fog mixed in towards the coast.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Monday

Wind: Winds will remain out of the NW throughout Monday. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 13-18 kts through 7 PM, with winds gradually decreasing after that time to 3-8 kts by 12 AM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18-23 kts through 7 PM, at which time they begin a gradual decrease to 4-9 kts by 12 AM. The Boarding Station remains slightly higher at 6-11 kts. Wind gusts of 25-30 kts possible for all Stations through 7 PM.













Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure

- The active weekend continues, making way for dry conditions to start the next week. Above normal temperatures favored for the week ahead.
- > Slightly above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps expected to be seasonable to just below normal.
- Below normal temperatures and much above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks 3/4 timeframe.
