

 Now 9 AM FRI Low Med
- Low confidence exists in patchy sea fog development given the timing of drizzle / light rain moving in from the west and thick cloud cover.
- ➤ North of Morgan's Point: Fog risks favored to be very low, but can't rule out patchy reduced visibilities of 2 3 miles from 5AM 8AM. More than likely, reduced visibilities will be attributed to drizzle vs fog.
- ➤ South of Morgan's Point: Due to consistent south / southeasterly winds and equal sea surface / air temperatures, sea fog risks can't be ruled out. 3AM − 9AM will be the greatest risk for patchy sea fog, with locally less than a mile visibility in play. Once again, as drizzle pushes in from the west, this will likely aid in keeping the fog risk localized and not dense (less than a mile). Nevertheless, can't be ruled out.
- > Risk will be patchier than want simulated visibility graphic shows above.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring scattered to widespread light rain showers to increase in coverage after 5AM and continue through the late evening hours. A few moderate pulses can't be ruled out.

Wind: Winds will be variable throughout the day, starting out of the southeast and then veering counter-clockwise, becoming out of the northeast by late evening. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 6 - 10 kts through 1PM before briefly becoming 10 -15kts through 5PM. Winds will then decrease back 7- 10 kts for the remainder of day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 - 12 kts throughout the day. Gusts of 22 - 28 kts will be possible from 12PM - 6PM CT as first front passes through area.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Lower 60s F




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Light showers / drizzle will be exiting the area through 6AM-CT. Dry conditions favored for the remainder of the day.


Wind: Due to passage of front, winds will remain elevated and out of the N for all of Saturday. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 11 -15 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18 -23 kts throughout the day. Gusts of up to 30 kts can't be ruled from 8AM through 8PM.

High Temps: Much Cooler N of Morgan's Point: Low to Mid 50s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 50s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog risk.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Sunday.





Wind Speed: 9 AM CT








Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure
