




Max wave heights at the Boarding Station will gradually increase to 4 – 5 ft no later than 8AM-CT this morning.

Waves will not decrease back to /below 3ft for for the boarding station until after 12AM CT Friday. Potential exists for this risk to end slightly earlier, but lower confidence.

Houston Pilots Extended Range Visibility Report






A low-end risk for fog will be possible SUN AM however slightly elevated winds may limit widespread nature


Forecast Discussion

Precip: Scattered light rain showers could begin as early at 8 AM, with 20% chances continuing through 4PM. Beyond 4PM, chances will slightly increase to 40%, although best potential for more widespread coverage will remain just N of stations.

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/NE throughout the day on THU. N Morgan's Point: 7 – 12 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 20-25 kts through 12 PM before calming to 15-20 kts for the PM hours (Boarding Stations will be same timeframes for decreasing on THU, but increased magnitudes of 3kts). Wind gusts of up to 25-35 kts possible S of Morgan's Point for the entire day, especially for the boarding station.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered light rain showers (30% chances) will continue through 8 AM CT for all stations. Dry conditions favored the rest of the day on FRI except for stations 11/12 and the boarding station, as 20% chances of rain will continue.

Wind: Winds out of the NE through 12 PM before shifting to out of the SE by 6 PM and continuing the rest of the evening while intensity gradually weakens. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 3-8 kts the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10-15 kts through 11 AM before decreasing to 8-13kts. Winds will then decrease again to 3-8 kts by 4 PM as a front stalls over the area.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Saturday.


Wind: Winds will remain calm and variable through 8AM before turning out of the E to out of the S through the early evening. N of Morgan's Point: Winds expected to remain calm until 12PM, when winds of 3 – 7 kts will be in play. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will sit at 4 – 8 kts from 8AM onward for the rest of the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 60s F.

Visibility: Sea fog is favored to develop after 2AM and continue to be a risk through 10AM, although confidence on exact timing and coverage remains lower at present.

Precip Image: 1 PM CT








High Temps Saturday
