

FORECAST NOTES

Current Weather Alerts:

Special WX Statement / Bursts of Snow

Temperatures:

✓ High temperatures today will top out in the upper 30s F. Lows Friday AM will sit in the low 20s F / upper 30s F.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Winds are out of the E this AM at 13 18 MPH, however will shift after ~12 PM-CT to 8 – 13 MPH out of the NNE. Gusts may reach up to 20 MPH this evening.
- ✓ Expecting clouds remain widespread / overcast today as snow showers progress through the area.

Today's Precipitation Chances:

Scattered light to at times moderate snow showers will continue through about 11 AM-CT today. After 11 AM-CT, there will be a bit of a break with some flurries mixing in. By 3 PM-CT snow showers may begin to push back in. Between $\sim 4 - 6$ PM-CT today is when Chicago will see the greatest risk for moderate to heavy snow showers that will bring the most accumulation. After ~ 6 PM-CT, chances will becoming more sporadic. Marginal temps will help with some melting, however under a more moderate to heavy pulse there will likely be slushy impacts, especially on untreated surfaces and within that 4 - 6 PM timeframe.

Rain + Snow Totals:

Favoring snowfall totals realized to sit in the 0.5 – 1.5" range. Favoring totals heavier than 1.5" to sit just N. of Chicago however a southerly trend is worth keeping an eye on at this risk cannot 100% be ruled out.

Dew/Frost:

Sporadic snow showers will be pushing in through the overnight period, bringing a light accumulation risk on surfaces.

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

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES:

- ✓ <u>SAT:</u> Aside from a potential stray AM flurry / an isolated light snow shower prior to 8 AM, the day is looking dry.
- ✓ <u>SUN:</u> Low confidence present, but it is likely the AM remains dry with only a 10% chance for a stray flurry. Placement of a warm front can cause stray light precipitation in the afternoon as well. The risk is simply this day remains dry.
- ✓ MON: The AM would risk trending drier as well. There will be notable heavy rain moving in, but latest data suggests this will not arrive until very late PM.
- <u>▼ TUE:</u> Some scattered light showers will be possible through the morning however then drier conditions will work in for the second half of the day.
- ✓ <u>WED:</u> Rain chances will have pushed off E of the Chicago area, however backside flurries cannot be ruled out behind this main system early in the AM Wednesday. The rest of the day favored to be dry.

Temperatures:

- ✓ Temperatures are moving to be slightly cooler than normal for the week ahead.
- ✓ For the most part, temps will remain in the low to mid 30s F with temperatures slightly rising to the low 40s F after the front passes.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ After a cloudy day today and early Saturday, it's possible sunshine can work back in Sat. PM. Front there sun will peek through between storms.
- ✓ Winds will generally remain in the 5 15 MPH range through the weekend, picking up ahead of the front through early next week.
- Minor mention would be to watch for some isolated gusts with the cold front FRI PM / early SAT AM of 30+ mph.
