  CURRENT 11 AM THU LOW
- We continue to grow more confident that visibility conditions will remain greatly improved.
- ➤ Visibility is reduced to 2 4 miles this morning across all stations with the greatest risk for 2 miles lingering over Houston Metro. Visibility will only continue to improve over the next few hours for all stations.
- ➤ Expecting the fog risk to clear out by 10 11 AM today, leaving all stations back in clear conditions. Will need to monitor for low cloud deck / hazy conditions of 3 5 miles for the boarding station through the early afternoon.
- Watching for fog to redevelop Friday morning.


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored for today.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70's F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F.


Visibility: Winds out of the S/SE will help to bring in a few instances of patchy fog within the Bay. See visibility slide for more information.

## **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Need to watch for scattered shower potential between 12AM – 9AM. Majority of coverage will remain to the north, but a few downpours can't be ruled out (20% chances). Beyond 9AM and through about 3PM, a few scattered storms will be in play with low end severe potential for winds / hail. (30% chances).

Wind: Winds will begin out of the south before veering out of the SW/WSW. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7 – 12 kts through 6 PM before weakening to 3 – 8 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10 – 15 kts will be likely throughout the day. Gusts up to 30-35 kts cannot be ruled out through 9 AM due to isolated storm risk.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60's F.


Visibility: Favoring the storm system Friday to limit the fog risk in the AM. However, we will need to watch for the possibility fog fills back in after this system passes.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored for Saturday.

Wind: Winds will shift from out of the SE to out of the N / NW given passage of front. N Morgan's Point: Winds will remain at 5 – 10 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 12 – 17 kts through 5 PM before decreasing slightly to 7 - 12 kts.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.


Visibility: Calm winds after Friday rains can allow for fog formation Saturday AM, but confidence remains very low given winds quickly veering out of the north.

Wind Speed 11 AM CT








#### **Next 7 Day Temperature Departure**




**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 




**8-14** Day Temperature Departure

- Slightly above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps expected to be seasonable to slightly below normal.
- ➤ Below normal temperatures and seasonable chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ¾ timeframe.
