




#### 3 PM CT FRI VISIBILITY



- Confidence is increasing that we will see fog redevelop Friday morning, continuing to grow in coverage through the PM until the cold front passes, pushing fog far out into the Gulf. A couple showers could result in fog being slightly more patchy at times.
- Around 3 AM CT Friday we need to watch for patchy fog development reducing visibility to 3 – 5 miles, possibly to less than 1 mile at the Boarding Station.
- Foggy conditions will only grow in coverage through the late morning, becoming the most dense from 10 AM – 5 PM. This is when fog will be widespread from Morgan's Point through the Boarding Station, dropping visibility to 0.5 or less.
- After 5 PM, fog will retreat out of the Bay back towards the Gulf, however linger over Station 11/12 and the Boarding Station through ~12 AM Sat until the front passes from NW to SE, taking the foggy conditions with it.


6 PM CT

**Precip:** A few scattered , light showers may push into the area as early as 6 PM CT. Coverage will remain low (20%) through the PM.


Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE throughout the day. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 10 – 15 kt expected for the rest of the PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 7-12 kts through 4 PM, then winds will slightly increase to 15 – 20 kts for the rest of the PM. Gusts may reach 20 – 25 kts with an isolated gust near 30 kts around 12 AM.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 60's F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.

#### Visibility: Not anticipating any visibility concerns for the PM.







#### Precip Image: 1 PM CT




**Precip:** Need to watch for scattered shower potential between 12AM – 9AM. Majority of coverage will remain to the north, but a few downpours can't be ruled out (20% chances). Beyond 9AM and through about 3PM, a few scattered storms will be in play with low end severe potential for winds / hail. (30% chances).


Wind: Winds will begin out of the south before veering out of the SW/WSW. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7 – 12 kts through 6 PM before weakening to 3 – 8 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10 – 15 kts will be likely throughout the day. Gusts up to 25 - 30 kts cannot be ruled out through 9 AM due to isolated storm risk.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60's F.

Visibility: Favoring the storm system Friday to limit the fog risk in the AM. However, we will need to watch for the possibility fog fills back in after this system passes.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored for Saturday.

Wind: Winds will shift from out of the SE to out of the N / NW given passage of front. N Morgan's Point: Winds will remain at 5 – 10 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 12 – 17 kts through 5 PM before decreasing slightly to 7 - 12 kts.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.


Visibility: Calm winds after Friday rains can allow for fog formation Saturday AM, but confidence remains very low given winds quickly veering out of the north.

Wind Speed 11 AM CT


