



#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions today outside of light drizzle after 7 PM.

Wind: Winds out of the NE will veer out of the E by 11 AM, then veer out of the SE by 3 PM. Winds continue a slow shift in the PM and will be from the S by 12 AM. N Morgan's Point: Winds expected to remain at 3-8 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: A gradual decline in speeds continues, with 14-19 kts prior to 5 AM, then from 10 AM - 3 PM winds will calm to 10-15 kts. After 3 PM, winds will continue to calm to 6-11 kts and remain there the rest of the day Wind gusts of 20-25 kts possible for Stations S of Morgan's Point through 8 AM.





#### **Forecast Discussion**

Precip: Isolated pockets of drizzle will be in play throughout the day (~10%) on Wednesday, however most stations will see predominantly dry conditions

Wind: Winds out of the SSE to SE throughout Wednesday. N of Morgan's Point: Near-calm at 2 - 5 kts prior to 11 AM, increasing to 4 - 9 kts thereafter. S of Morgan's Point: 3 - 7 kts prior to 2 PM, increasing to 7 - 12 kts at 2 PM and continuing at that clip for the PM.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 70 F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 60s F





#### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Scattered light showers/storms will work their way into the area Thursday morning, with coverage increasing throughout the PM hours. Stronger storms will be able to produce wind gusts of 30-40 kts.

Wind: Winds out of the SE throughout Thursday. N Morgan's Point: 4-9 kts through 10 AM before increasing to 7-12 kts through 8 PM. Winds then decrease again to 4-9 kts the rest of the PM. S of Morgan's Point: 7-12 kts throughout the day outside of a slight increase to 9-15 kts from 2-7 PM. Wind gusts of up to 22-27 kts will be possible during the PM hours, with stronger gusts of 30-40 kts under stronger storms.





Wind Speed 3 PM CT
























- Favoring conditions to dry out to start the beginning of the week. With precip chances to work back in starting Thursday. Temps expected to be below normal.
