

- Scattered Showers and Storm chances begin to gradually increase by Thursday PM and continue through Sunday.
- Winds will remain generally mild with non storm related gusts reaching up to 25 kts at times.
- Fog risks favored for this afternoon and into tomorrow. See visibility slides for more details.



A lower confidence forecast today as slightly elevated winds and pockets of drizzle may allow for some mixing, reducing fog risk. However, right now we are anticipating patchy fog to work over the Boarding Station and into station 11/12 after 12 PM today, reducing visibility down to 1 – 3 miles with visibility dropping to less than 1 mile at times.

Max: 10.10 + Min: 0.00

- > Fog will increase in coverage and become more dense through the early PM. By 6 PM, this fog will begin to creep N into Galv. Bay, reaching Morgan's Point by 9 PM tonight, dropping visibility to less than 0.5 mile for all stations S of Morgan's Point.
- This dense fog risk is expected to continue through the rest of the evening and into Thursday. (See next slide)
- Stations N of Morgan's Point not expected to see impacts outside of a haze with visibility down to 7 miles.




- > The dense fog risk is expect to continue into Thursday AM, impacting all stations S of Morgan's Point with visibility below 0.5 mile. Stations N of Morgan's Point still not favored to see anything more than drizzle and hazy conditions, briefly reducing visibility to 3 – 5 miles at times.
- This dense fog will begin to recede after 10 11 AM CT, becoming more patchy in nature. Visibility will also gradually improve, increasing to 1-2 miles by noon.
- > By 1 PM, anticipating this fog risk to have cleared up for all stations.
- > Overall, this forecast still has some lower confidence as drizzle and slightly elevated winds are expected to continue.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Isolated drizzle/light showers will be possible for much of the day, especially before 3PM. After 3PM, would anticipate drier conditions to fill in.

Wind: Winds out of the SE for the entire day. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts through 11 AM before increasing to 9-13 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7-12 kts through 7 PM before increasing to 11-16 kts. Wind gusts of 20-22 kts possible in the PM hours.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: High 70's / Low 80's F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F.

Visibility: Another low-end risk of fog remains this AM into early PM before winds increase in the late PM hours. See Visibility Slide for more details.

Forecast Discussion

5 PM CT

Precip: Isolated light showers will be possible after 2AM through ~ 10AM. Beyond 4PM, a few scattered showers / storms can't be ruled out.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SSE for the entire day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 6-11 kts through 10 AM before increasing to 15-20 kts. Winds remain at this clip through 8 PM before decreasing to 5-10 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 15-20 kts through 10 PM before decreasing to 12-17 kts. Wind gusts of 25-35 kts will be possible from 10 AM to 10 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to Mid 70's F.


Visibility: Patchy Sea fog risks can't be ruled out, but presence of drizzle and higher winds will be mitigating factors.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Showers and storms are favored to increase in coverage beyond 4PM, with a line of storms likely to impact all stations after 6PM. A few strong to severe storms will be in play with large hail and damaging wind gusts of 40 - 50 kts.


Wind: Winds out of the S / SSE throughout the day before veering out of the N immediately following the passage of front / storm line. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 7 - 13 kts through 10PM, then winds slightly decrease to 5 - 8 kts. S of Morgan's Point: 12 - 16 kts expected for the entire day. Non-thunderstorm gusts of 18 - 23 kts cannot be ruled out throughout the PM prior to passage of front..

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to Mid 70s F.


Visibility: Needing to watch timing of precip on FRI, but SE winds would allow for foggy setup behind rain chances. Heavier downpours can result in reduced visibilities as well.

ECMWF 0.1' Init 002 13 Mar 2024 + 10m Wind Speed + 5tre



Wind Speed 10 AM CT





- Slightly above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps expected to be below normal.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
