






TIMEFRAME DISCUSSED	THREAT
CURRENT - 10 AM CT	Low

- ➤ Hi-resolution model data continues to be overdone with low level saturation estimation and as a result, sea fog/fog will not be nearly as extensive as previously mentioned
- Locations that can see some patchiness of 3-5 mi visibility would be near just Morgan's Point and EXXON 3 through 10 AM CT
- ➤ The mouth of the Bay at 25/26 and stations south (11/12 + Boarding Station) can also see some slightly reduced visibility of 3 -5 mi where there is slightly more available low-level saturation.
- ➤ Watching the next wave of sea fog threats to roll in near 9 PM tonight. Check the following slide for more details.









- TIMEFRAME THREAT
 DISCUSSED

 9 PM CT SAT 12 PM CT SUN Medium High
- ➤ Winds in the PM will shift from the SE by 4 PM this afternoon, and this will set the pre-stage for sea fog development after sunset.
- ➤ Wind speeds increase slightly from 4 8 kts at the Boarding Station to 7 -11 kts by 10 PM. This slight uptick in the winds will help transport/initiate sea fog development
- ➤ Lower confidence is present on a start time, but 9 PM would be the earliest to watch this impact the Boarding Station + 11/12 first and expand from south to north. This risk is timing can be delayed a couple hours near 11 PM for this to initiate as there can be a slight lagged response in the uptick of winds to transport fog from the south.
- From there, coverage only expands north from roughly 11 PM 1AM. Visibility of <1 mi favored for locations south of 51/52 while north of 51/52 can see ranges of 2 3 mi.</p>
- Fog coverage remains persistent during the AM hours of Sunday. Coverage can start to become more patchy in nature after 7 AM through 10 AM, but more future updates will be needed.




Precip: Favoring dry conditions for today.

N of Morgan's Point: Winds expected to remain calm until 12PM, when winds of 3 – 7 kts will be in play. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will sit at 4 – 8 kts from 8AM onward for the rest of the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 60s F.


Visibility: Sea fog is favored to be present between 2 AM and 11 AM, although confidence on exact coverage remains lower. See visibility slide for more info.


Precip: Isolated showers (10%) will be in play between 10 AM and 7 PM. Dry conditions favored for all other parts of Sunday.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE throughout the day SUN. N Morgan's Point: 4 – 9 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4 - 9 kts through 7 PM, increasing to 7 – 12 kts after that time.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70's-Low 80's F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s-Low 70s F.




Precip: Hit/miss pockets of light showers (10%) will be in play through much of the AM before coverage begins increasing at 10 AM. Scattered showers (30-40%) will then decrease in coverage again after 4 PM, with hit/miss light showers lingering through the remainder of the evening.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE throughout the day Monday. N Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will remain at 7-12 kts throughout the day. Wind gusts of 8 – 13 will be possible for stations N of Morgan's Point after 9 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70's-Low 80's F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s-Low 70s F.



Wind Speed: 7 AM CT









