

# Weather Headlines

- Some stronger storms are favored for the evening with rain chances continuing off and on through the weekend.
- Winds will remain generally mild with non storm related gusts reaching up to 25 kts at times. Storm related gusts may reach near 60 kts this evening.
- Patchy Fog risks favored along the Coastline and at the Boarding Station this afternoon and Saturday. See visibility slide below for more information.






- Patchy to widespread fog has receded S. leaving improved visibility of 4 − 6 miles N of Stations 37/38 and visibility of 1 − 2 miles from station 37/38 through the Boarding Station with frequent instances of visibility dropping to less than 1 mile. (this will continue to be a risk if rain chances can remain N of station 37/38) This risk is favored to last through 9 PM.
- ▶ Beyond 9 PM, there is lower confidence due to wind direction, however winds shift primarily out of the E but will calm, possibly allowing a brief break in fog before we see redevelopment after 4 AM, pushing N into Morgan's Point, bringing a risk for visibility reduced to less than 1 mile for stations S of Morgan's Point and to 1 2 miles for stations N of Morgan's Point. This risk then lasting through Saturday morning.
- ➤ Regardless, there is a risk patchy to widespread dense fog will linger along the coastline and into the Gulf, reducing visibility to 0.5 1 mile for stations 11/12 and the Boarding Station.



- ➤ Lower confidence for the Saturday AM fog risk. However it is possible the front moving through Friday will help to briefly clear up foggy conditions after 9 PM Friday with these cleared conditions continuing until ~4 AM.
- ➤ Around 4 AM, anticipating this fog to push back in from the South moving North into the Boarding Station and station 11/12 reducing visibility to less than 1 mile. Stations N of 11/12 not favored to see impacts outside of hazy conditions.
- ➤ Around 11 AM 12 PM CT Saturday, another wave of precip moving in from the W/SW will help to push fog out of the area, clearing up visibility for all stations outside of hazy conditions at times caused by heavy downpours.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: A few scattered showers and storm are expected to continue through the early afternoon. Around 3 – 4 PM, storms will increase in coverage forming a broken line just west of stations. These storms will push W to E bringing strong to severe potential through 10 PM. The strongest storms will be capable of producing hail, strong gusts of around 60 MPH and lightning. The tornado risk is non-zero.

Wind: Winds out of the ESE through much of the afternoon and evening ahead of main front. Winds will become slightly more variable / out of the E around 8 PM as the front stalls along the coastline. N Morgan's Point: Non-storm related winds at 8 – 13 kt through the rest of the PM. S of Morgan's Point: Non-storm winds favored at around 15 – 20 for the rest of the evening. Non-thunderstorm gusts of 20 – 25 kts cannot be ruled out throughout the PM prior to passage of front.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to Mid 60s F.


Visibility: Patchy / patchy dense fog is favored to linger in the Gulf through the evening as storms will be occurring at stations N of the Coastline. See visibility slide.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Scattered to organized pockets of storms will be possible after 2 PM. Severe threat appears low, but a few localized storm gusts of 40 – 50 kts and pockets of hail can't be ruled out.

Wind: Winds will be out of N/NNE before 8AM before returning to out of the ESE / SE. N Morgan's Point: Winds expected to remain at 3 - 6 kts through 2 PM. After 2 PM, winds of 5 - 8 kts will be possible. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7 - 10 kts will be possible for the entire day. Wind gusts of 25 kts possible after 3 PM CT for stations S of Morgan's Point.





### **Forecast Discussion**

Precip: Scattered showers and storms continue into SUN AM, becoming widespread in nature by 6 AM. Lightning, pockets of hail and 30-40 kt gusts cannot be ruled out with storm. Widespread showers and storms gradually slide to the East and become scattered once again by 2 PM, before tapering off at 7 PM.

Wind: Winds will be variable through 1 PM before settling out of the NE at that time. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 2-7 kts through 5 PM, increasing to 4-9 kts after that time. S of Morgan's Point: 5-10 kts through 11 AM, decreasing to 3-8 kts after that time before returning to 5-10 kts by 8 PM.














### **8-14** Day Temperature Departure
