

- TIMEFRAME THREAT
 DISCUSSED

 Current 12 PM CT SUN Medium High
- ➤ Lighter green colors on 'Current Visibility' satellite imagery represent ongoing patchy fog.
- Wind speeds have increased to 7-11 kts, helping to transport/initiate sea fog development
- ➤ Lower confidence remains at this time however this patchy fog risk will continue to gradually expand from south to north and become denser in nature through 11 PM. Visibility of <1 mi favored for locations south of Morgan's Point while north of Morgan's Point can see ranges of 2 3 mi.
- ➤ Fog coverage remains persistent during the AM hours of Sunday. Coverage can start to become patchier in nature after 7 AM through 10 AM, but more future updates will be needed.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the remainder of the day.

Wind: Winds will shift out of the SE by ~4 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3 – 7 kts in play through the evening. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will sit at 4 – 8 kts for the rest of the day. Winds can be slightly higher at 7-11 kts near the Boarding Station by 10 PM.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.


Visibility: With the shifting of winds out of the SE and a slight uptick in speeds at the mouth of bay, the risk for sea fog development will be in play after sunset. See Visibility Slide for more details.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Isolated showers (10%) will be in play between 10 AM and 7 PM. Dry conditions favored for all other parts of Sunday.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE throughout the day SUN. N Morgan's Point: 4 – 9 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4 - 9 kts through 7 PM, increasing to 7 – 12 kts after that time.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70's-Low 80's F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s-Low 70s F.


Visibility: A lingering low-end risk for fog will be in play early SUN AM as conditions become favorable for sea fog. See Visibility Slide for more details.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Hit/miss pockets of light showers (10%) will be in play through much of the AM before coverage begins increasing at 10 AM. Scattered showers (30-40%) will then decrease in coverage again after 4 PM to be hit/miss again. Heavier showers and storms associated with a passing front will be in play after 10 PM. Lightning and small hail cannot be ruled out with these storms.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE throughout the majority of the day Monday. Winds become variable in direction after 10 PM with a passing front. N Morgan's Point: 3-8 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will remain at 7-12 kts throughout the day. Wind gusts of 8 – 13 will be possible for stations N of Morgan's Point after 9 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70's-Low 80's F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s-Low 70s F.


Visibility: Not favoring a fog risk for Monday but will need to watch trends if at least a patchier risk can develop for the Boarding Station prior to 10 AM. Confidence remains low.

Wind Speed: 7 PM CT













Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure
