

Houston Pilots Wave Height Update






Significant Wave Height Image

Waves remain choppy this morning due to some elevated winds out of the SSE. Wave heights at and S of stations 11/12 at 4 - 5 ft this AM. By 7 PM CT, wave heights of 5 - 6 ft will creep N, primarily impacting the Boarding Station.

From 7 PM TUE through 7 AM WED, wave heights at the Boarding Station will sit in the 5 – 6 ft range. After 7 AM, waves heights will slightly decrease to 4 – 5 ft. It won't be until 10 PM CT WED that wave heights drop to 3 – 4 ft at the Boarding Station.

Looking at 10 PM THU for waves heights to drop to 1 – 2 ft at the Boarding Station.



- ➤ Low confidence exists as not all models are in agreement for a fog risk Wednesday morning, however it is enough of a risk to mention in this report. Visibility would be reduced to 1 2 miles from heavy downpours and possible less than 1 where fog can develop.
- Patchy / patchy dense fog may develop out ahead of the front / storm system pushing through the HOU / GALV Bay region early Wednesday morning.
- ➤ If this fog can develop, anticipating it sets up over the Gulf as early as 4 AM, impacting stations primarily south of stations S of Morgan's Point with the Boarding Station seeing the best chance. Fog would exit around 10 AM.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Anticipating showers and storms remain N of all stations throughout the PM. Greatest risk for a light pocket of showers to push through (10%) would be between 6 – 8 PM CT.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SSE throughout the PM. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 13 – 18 kts through 8 PM CT, then winds will slightly decrease. To 8 – 13 kts for the rest of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 14 – 19 kts for the rest of the PM. Wind gusts 28 kts cannot be ruled out throughout the PM, especially N of Morgan's Point.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Near 70 F.


Visibility: No visibility concerns for this evening. Hazy conditions, some patchy fog may develop within the Gulf early Wed AM.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers and storms will move in around 1AM Wednesday. Scattered storms will then move in as early as 3-4 AM, however the best risk for strong to severe storms will move in from ~5 – 9 AM CT. Hail, lightning, wind gusts of 45 - 55 kts possible with these storms. Need to watch for an iso tornado risk and hail. Favoring conditions to dry out after 10AM-CT, remaining dry until a few iso showers move through around 8 PM.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE to begin before gradually veering clockwise throughout the day. Winds will be out of the SW ~5 AM CT, the W ~9 AM CT, and eventually settling out of the NW by ~12 PM CT. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 9-14 kts through 12 PM before increasing to 14-19 kts the rest of the day S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 19-24 kts through 9 AM before decreasing to 12-17 kts. Winds increase again to 18-23 kts after 6 PM. Wind gusts of 22-27 kts through 5 PM at all stations with increased gusts of 30-35 kts after 5 PM S of Morgan's Point.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Thursday.

Wind: Favoring wind to be out of the SW throughout the day Thursday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will decrease from 14-19 kts down to 8-13 kts by 8AM and remain there for the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds decrease from 23-28 kts to 12-17 kts by 11AM and remain there for the rest of the evening. Before 6AM wind gusts of 30-35 kts will be possible S of stations 11/12.





Wind Speed 8 AM CT








Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure
