

Weather Headlines

- Outside of a front passing through and providing rain chances this morning, a primarily drier week lies ahead.
- Wave heights of 3-4 ft will be possible at the outer most stations and continue through WED.
- Outside of a patchy fog risk this morning, not anticipating much in terms of visibility concerns over the next few days.
- Periods of elevated wind gusts to continue over the next few days






Currently still monitoring a low-end risk for wave heights near Station 11/12 and the Boarding Station of nearing above 4 ft over the next few days.


Right now, favoring heights at the outer most stations to remain between 3-4 ft throughout the day.

While wave heights are expected to gradually decreasing starting TUE PM, risk will be that they can remain in the 3-4 ft range through WED. A low-end risk of waves up to 5 feet will be possible near the boarding station WED morning.


Houston Pilots Visibility Report


Sea fog has already begun to work into locations offshore. Patchy dense	
fog with visibilities of 1-2 miles will be possible this morning. Continuing to	
see the most widespread fog remain to the NE of stations.	

- Greatest risk period will begin at 3AM-CT Tuesday and continue through 9AM-CT Tuesday. All locations S of Morgan's point will be at risk for patchy dense fog with the greatest risk area being near the boarding station where localized pockets of 1–2 mile visibilities will be possible.
- Nearing 9AM-CT favoring fog potential to begin breaking up with the arrival of the front and light precip. Between 9 AM and 12 PM a mixture of patchy fog and light rain/mist will continue to keep visibilities between 2-4 miles until the front completely passes through the area.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: As a front passes through this morning, light rain will be possible from 3 AM through ~2 PM CT. Dry conditions afterwards.


Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE through 12 PM before gradually shift to being out of the once a front passes. Winds will remain there for the PM hours. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts through 3 PM before increasing to 11-17 kts the rest of TUE. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will decrease to 5-10 kts by 3 AM. Winds will remain there for the majority of the day before increasing by 8 PM and settling at 25-30 kts. Wind gusts of 30-35 kts (locally up to 40 kts S of Morgan's Point) will be possible after 8 PM


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F





Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Wednesday.


Wind: Winds will be out of the NW the entire day. N Morgan's Point: Winds at 6-11 kts through 12 PM before increasing to 9-14 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds of 25-30 kts through 8 AM before gradually decreasing to 15-20 kts by 12 PM and remaining there the rest of the day Wind gusts of up to 30-35 kts possible S of Morgan's Point through 9 AM on WED.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Thursday.








High Temps Thursday
