

Weather Headlines


- Anticipating multiple periods of showers and storms to be in play throughout the next few days. (Details on current storms MON AM on next slide)

- Wave heights of ~6 ft will continue through this morning, gradually decreasing starting late this morning.



Significant Wave Height Image






Wave heights are around 6 ft for Station 11/12 and the Boarding Station. They will continue to gradually decrease throughout the day MON

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers/storms will continue to push through the area this morning through 10 AM CT before becoming more hit/miss. Dry conditions favored after 2 PM CT Risks with storms will be lightning, hail and 40-50 kts through 7 AM CT today.

Wind: Favoring wind to continue out of the S/SE through 7 AM, becoming variable after that time. Winds settle out of the SE again by 8 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 8-13 kts through 5 AM, decreasing to 4-9 kts after that time. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 23-28 kts quickly decrease to 7-12 kts by 10 AM. Non storm wind gusts of 35-40 kts possible for Stations S of Morgan's Point through 7 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s - Near 80 F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for Monday once again due to high winds. Visibilities can be reduced to less than 1 mile under the heaviest of downpours.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers and a few storms possible from **11** AM - 5 PM TUE with dry conditions favored outside of this timeframe.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the day TUE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts throughout day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 6-11 kts throughout the entire day TUE.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F S of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s-Near 80 F.


Visibility: A low end fog risk for TUE AM, however favoring coverage to remain north of stations at this time.


Precip: Scattered showers and a few storms will be possible during the PM hours on WED.




High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F S of Morgan's Point: Upper 70's F.

Precip Image: 2 PM CT








High Temps Wednesday

- Slightly below normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe, however risk would be to trend to be more seasonal. Temps are expected to be slightly above normal.
- Above normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe. Temperatures expected to be near normal for the weeks 3 and 4 timeframe.
