



Wave heights will gradually decrease in the afternoon, however stations 11/12 and the boarding station will still be at risk for waves at/near 6 ft into MON AM



Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring the potential for scattered thunderstorms to begin at 4PM and continuing throughout the evening. Main risks with storms are favored to be lightning and hail, with some localized gusts reaching 35-40 kts (especially after 9 PM).


Wind: Winds out of SE throughout today. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 12-17 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 15-20 kts through 9 PM before increasing again to 22-27 kts. Wind gusts of 35-40 kts possible for all Stations throughout the remainder of the day.

Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F S of Morgan's Point: Low 70's F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for Sunday due to high winds.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers/storms to continue pushing through the area through 10 AM CT MON before becoming more hit/miss the rest of the day. Risks with storms will be lightning, hail and 30-35 kts through 10 AM CT.

Wind: Favoring wind to continue out of the S/SE through 7 AM, becoming variable after that time. Winds settle out of the SE again by 5 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 8-13 kts through 3 AM, decreasing to 4-9 kts after that time. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18-23 kts quickly decrease to 7-12 kts by 10 AM. Non storm wind gusts of 30-35 kts possible for Stations S of Morgan's Point through 7 AM.




Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for Monday once again due to high winds. Visibilities can be reduced to less than 1 mile under the heaviest of downpours.

Precip: Scattered showers and a few storms possible from 11 AM -6 PM TUE with dry conditions favored outside of this timeframe.













Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation





8-14 Day Temperature Departure
