

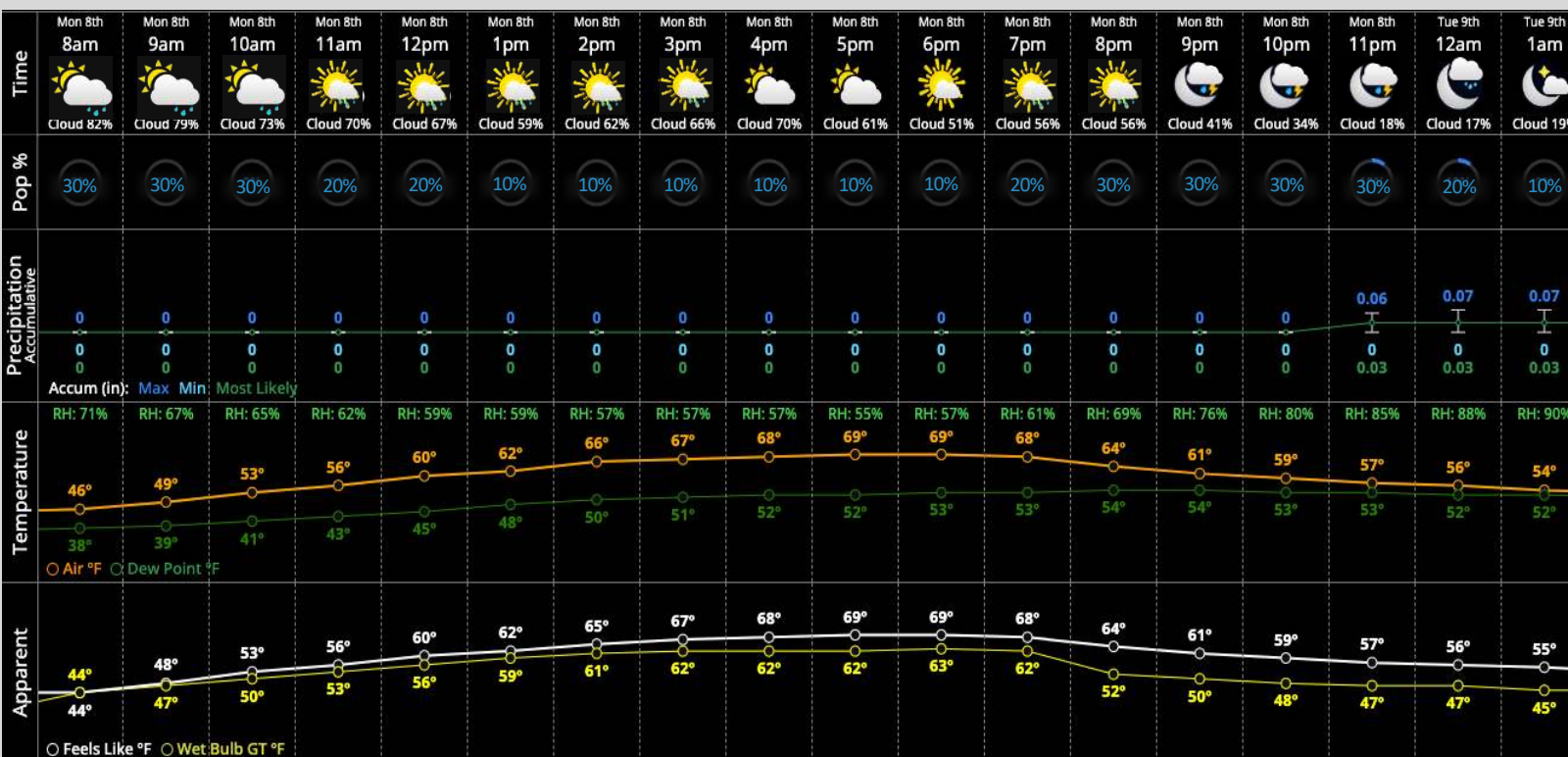

7:20 AM ET Weather Forecast



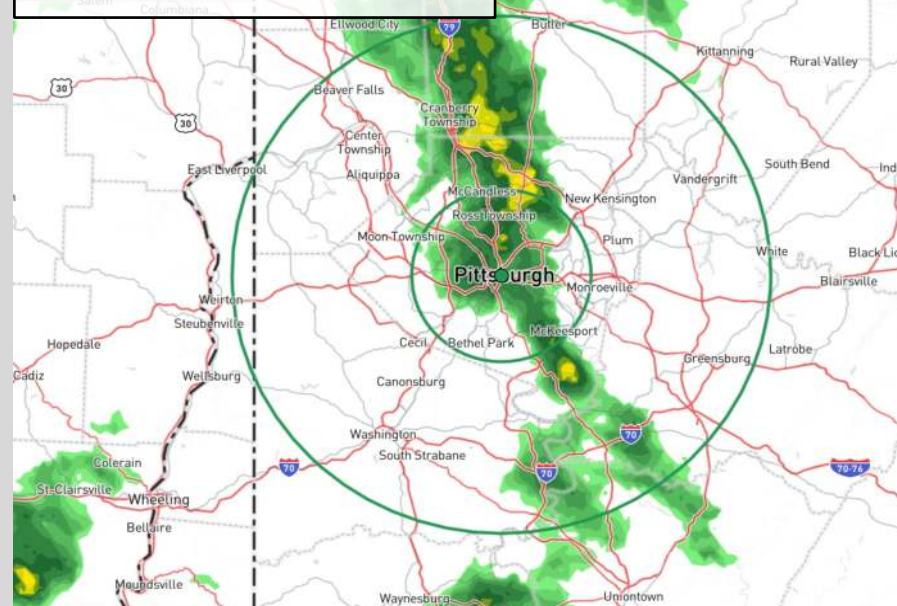
HOUR BY HOUR FORECAST:

IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 7:20 AM ET, 4/8/24):

- ✓ Scattered showers across the AM hours will keep chances near 30-40% through about 10 AM ET. After 10 AM through about 7 PM, chances become very isolated at 10-20%, but do not remain at 0. There will be far more dry time than wet in the early PM, but minor rain chances never fully diminish. Would have to watch near 8 PM for chances to increase again to near 30%. A weak boundary can cause some isolated T-storms, but the boundary looks to setup a few counties to the S near the state border. 8 PM - 11 PM would be the greatest risk window for this coverage. Rainfall totals today of around 0.05" to locally 0.08" favored in the AM (through 10 AM). 10 AM - 7 PM would offer light drizzle for up to 0.02" maximum. Lastly late PM T-storm coverage can offer 0.25 to locally 0.4" (favoring this to stay to the S for now)
- ✓ High temps this afternoon will top out in the upper 60s F to near 70 F. Low temperatures dip into the mid 40s F into Tuesday AM
- ✓ Winds will be quite calm today, like yesterday. S winds to start prior to 11 AM, shifting slowly from the SSW to SW thereafter. Speeds of 4 - 9 mph at play. With outflowing T-storms to the S in the late evening, a few gusts of up to 18 - 22 mph are possible (post 10 PM)

Dew Forecast

- ✓ Moderate to heavy dew formation is highly likely tomorrow with clearing clouds, SW flow and calmer winds (>80% chance to see dew)
