



  CURRENT 12 PM FRI LOW
- ➤ Hazy conditions / a low cloud deck is expected to continue for the Houston Metro / Galv. Bay region through ~12 PM Friday.
- ➤ Visibility for all stations will continue to sit generally in the 2 4 mile range for the rest of the evening, overnight and into tomorrow morning. That being said, between 3 7 AM CT, there is a low end risk for a couple isolated instances of visibility dropping to 1 mile or less for stations S of Morgan's Point.
- ➤ Anticipating these hazy conditions / low cloud deck clears up after the 12 PM timeframe tomorrow.

#### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: There is a low-end risk for drizzle N of Morgan's Point after 5 PM CT, however if any rain does move overhead, not anticipating much in the way of impacts.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 8-13 kts for the rest of the PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 15 - 20 kts for the rest of the PM with occasional gusts of 25 - 30 kts after 7-8 PM.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F.


Visibility: Hazy conditions reducing visibility to 2-4 miles will continue through the PM and into Fri.

#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** An isolated pocket of drizzle after 5 PM cannot be ruled out, however favoring dry conditions for Friday.

Wind: Winds will quickly shift after midnight where they will then be out of the NE for the entire day on Friday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 5-10 kts through 8 AM before increasing to 9-14 kts. Winds remain there through 5 PM before decreasing to 5-10 kts the rest of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 12-17 kts through 5 PM before decreasing to 9-14 kts the rest of the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F S of Morgan's Point: Low 80's F.



#### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored through 7 PM. Scattered showers will then be in play for all Stations after that time.

Wind: Winds begin the day out of the NE and gradually shift out of the ESE through 7 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts throughout Saturday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10-15 kts through 7 PM, decreasing to 7-12 kts after that time.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s F.


Visibility: Not favoring any fog concerns for Saturday.




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
**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 





8-14 Day Temperature Departure

- Outside of minor rain chances this PM/FRI AM, a drier start to the weekend ahead with next rain chances working in SAT PM. Temps are expected to be slightly above normal for the week 1 timeframe.
- > Slightly above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps are expected to be near normal.
- ➤ Below normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ¾ timeframe. Temperatures expected to be much above normal for the weeks 3 and 4 timeframe.
