

Significant Wave Height Image



Wave heights will continue to rise this evening getting up to ~3 – 3.5 ft at the Boarding Station by 4 PM today.

By late this PM, ~10 PM CT, wave heights will peak at around 4 ft at the Boarding Station. Waves will then be on a gradual decrease FRI AM. Waves will drop below 3 ft by 7 AM FRI.

Forecast Discussion

7 PM CT


Precip: Scattered showers/storms will continue throughout the rest of the day, especially for stations N of 75/76. Chances to become more widespread after 9 PM as a band of storms pushes SSE. Favoring the heaviest risk to remain just N of stations. Main risks are wind gusts of 30-40+ kts, lightning, and hail.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the majority of the PM. After the front passes around 11 PM / midnight, winds will shift out of the ENE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 13 – 18 kts through the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 23-28 kts for most of the evening then winds will decrease to 8 – 13 kts. Non-T-Storm gusts may reach 28-33 kts at times S of Morgan's Point for the PM.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 70s F S of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for today, however visibilities can be reduced under heavy downpours.

Precip Image: 6 PM CT








Low Temps FRI AM

Precip Image: 1 PM CT




Precip: Scattered shower / storm chances will be present for much of the day. Around 6 AM, 20% chances will be on the increase as activity becomes more widespread.
Between 8 – 11 AM, coverage will temporarily decrease. Then after 11 AM through ~10 PM, coverage will again become widespread with moderate to heavy showers / strong storms (strong winds, heavy downpours, lightning and hail all risks).


Wind: Winds to become variable just after midnight before settling out of the N/NW by 7 AM. Winds become variable once again after 3 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts for the day Friday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 19-24 kts quickly decrease to 10-15 kts by 6 AM then 5-10 kts after 4 AM. Thunderstorm wind gusts of 40-50 kts will be possible.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low/Mid 80s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for FRI, however visibilities can be reduced under heavy downpours.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for SAT, aside from isolated rain showers before 8AM.


Wind: Winds are favored to be variable throughout the day on Saturday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 2 - 7 kts throughout the day SAT. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 6 - 11 kts throughout the day SAT.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F.

Visibility: Monitoring the potential for patchy fog N of Morgan's point between 1AM and 10AM SAT morning.

Precip Image: 2 AM CT








High Temps Saturday

- A broken line of storms expected to bring a few downpours this evening. Then scattered rain chances are expected to last off and on into the weekend with another shot of heavy rain early Friday PM. The heaviest risk favored to sit just north of stations. Temps are expected to be slightly above normal for the week 1 timeframe.
- Below normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps are expected to be above normal.
- Below normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ³/₄ timeframe. Temperatures expected to be much above normal for the weeks 3 and 4 timeframe.
