



- 4 10 AM CT SAT

LOW

- ➤ Anticipating another low end risk for very patchy fog to develop between 4 10 AM Saturday.
- ➤ The overall threat remains fairly low tomorrow, however there is some data indicating a risk for visibility dropping to 1 3 miles in a very patchy fashion N of Morgan's Point.
- ➤ An isolated instance of visibility dropping to just less than a mile cannot be ruled out.
- > Expecting by 10 AM this threat will have lifted for the area.

### **Houston Pilots Wind Chart**







### **Forecast Discussion**

Precip: Shower and storm chances are expected to continue throughout much of the day. Scattered coverage is favored to become more widespread around 3 PM today. By 6-7 PM, coverage will once again be more scattered in nature and sit primarily over stations N of Morgan's Point. A small break in rain will be possible around 10 PM, however around midnight another round of storms are expected to push through. A few heavier downpours, lightning, gusty wind and isolated hail will all be a risk with these storms this afternoon.

Wind: Winds out of the N/NW at this time. By 8 PM, these winds are expected to become more variable. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts for the PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 13 – 18 kts through 7 PM CT, then winds decrease to 8 – 13 kts. Thunderstorm wind gusts of 30 – 40+ kts will be possible between 3 – 5 PM.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near to low 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any concerns with fog this evening however visibility may be slightly reduced under any heavy downpours.


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions for SAT, aside from a couple isolated rain showers before 8AM.

Wind: Winds are favored to be variable throughout the day on Saturday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 2 - 7 kts throughout the day SAT. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4 - 9 kts throughout the day SAT.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low/Mid 80s F.


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions throughout the day on Sunday.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F S of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F.


Visibility: Watching the potential for a window of patchy fog N of Morgan's point between 4 – 10 AM Sunday Morning.







**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 



**8-14** Day Temperature Departure




8-14 Day % of Average Precip.
