




  DISCUSSED

  4 10 AM CT SAT LOW
- ➤ Anticipating another risk for patchy fog to develop between 4 10
   AM Saturday morning for stations N of Morgan's Point.
- ➤ The overall threat remains low tomorrow, however there is some data indicating a risk for visibility dropping to 0.5 2 miles in a patchy fashion... Again for only stations N of Morgan's Point
- ➤ Not favoring this risk to extend further south due to cloud cover / winds.
- > Expecting 10 AM to be the latest this risk extends.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for today, aside from a couple isolated rain showers before 6AM for 11/12 and the Boarding Station. Storm risks to remain well to the southeast, but a few localized gusts of up to 30kts from the southeast can't be ruled out through 4AM

Wind: Winds are favored to be variable throughout the day on Saturday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 2 - 7 kts throughout today. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4 - 9 kts through 8PM before gradually increasing to 6 - 11kts.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 90 F. S of Morgan's Point: Low/Mid 80s F.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for most of the day on Sunday. Very Isolated Pop-Up (10%) chance from 7PM – 11PM.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S / SSW for most of the day, outside of a brief window from 12PM – 5PM where winds weaken and veer out of the ESE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4 – 9 kts for all of Sunday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 5-10 kts expected for the whole day outside of 12PM – 5PM when winds slightly weaken 3 – 6 kts.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 90 F S of Morgan's Point: Low to mid 80s F.


**Visibility:** Watching the potential for a window of patchy fog N of Morgan's point between 4 – 10 AM Sunday Morning. Confidence is low at this time.

### **Forecast Discussion**


**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions for all of Monday.

Wind: Winds out of the S for all of Monday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's **Point:** Winds at 7 – 10 kts through 4 PM CT, then winds increase to 10 - 15 kts. A few gusts of up to 25 kts for the Boarding Station after 4PM can't be ruled out.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog risks.

Wind Speed 7 AM CT











### Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 



**8-14** Day Temperature Departure




8-14 Day % of Average Precip.
