
Line of strong storms moving SE


- Strong-to-severe wind gusts can extend in front of the actual storm itself.
- Timing above shows the leading edge of strong winds. Threat for strong winds can linger behind that for ~30 minutes.
- Wind gusts of 60 70+ MPH, large hail, and an embedded tornado will be possible

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Storm chances have increased for the afternoon. Scattered to widespread storms are developing just N. of Houston. These storms are latching onto a front moving SSE, causing strong to severe storms to form into a line which will then push across Houston and Galveston Bay impacting all stations. These storms will bring a risk for lightning, strong wind gusts, large hail and heavy downpours. An isolated tornado or two cannot be ruled out. Favoring this back edge of this storm threat ends near ~8PM. Dry conditions to follow for the remainder of the PM.

Wind: Winds will be out of E/SE ahead of storms. Between 2 – 8 PM, winds will be more variable in nature. After 8 PM winds will again shift out of the ESE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 12 – 17 kts will increase to 25-35 kts (non-storm) from 2 – 7 PM. Then winds will calm to 2 – 5 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18-23 kts will increase between 3 – 8 PM to 25 – 35 kts calming to 2-7 kts thereafter. Damaging wind gusts of 50 - 60+ kts possible embedded within storms this PM.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s F S of Morgan's Point: Near to Mid 80s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating fog however visibility may be reduced under any downpour.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating scattered to widespread showers/storms out of the WNW work in around 3 – 4 AM, continuing through the 9-10 AM timeframe. Coverage is expected to become more isolated after 10 AM. Wind gusts of 30-40 kts will be possible with strongest storms before 10 AM.

Wind: Winds out of the S/SE throughout Wednesday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 8-13 kts through 1 PM, before decreasing to 5-10 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 17-22 kts during the AM hours on Wednesday before decreasing gradually to 11-16 kts by 2 PM and for the rest of the day. 20-25 kts wind gusts possible at all stations through 12 PM.






Precip: Favoring scattered showers/storms across the area throughout the day on THU, with best risk for widespread coverage from 12-6 PM.

Wind: Winds out of the S/SE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3-9 kts for THU. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10-15 kts throughout a majority of the day with a slight increase to 13-18 kts after 8 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid/Upper 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F.



Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure
