






 - 5 9 AM CT WED

- > Anticipating another low end risk for patchy fog to develop through the mid-morning Wednesday.
- ➤ At this time, not anticipating direct impacts to stations, however an isolated instance of visibility dropping to 2 4 miles cannot be ruled out between 5 9 AM CT Wednesday.
- ➤ If visibility can become reduced Wednesday morning, stations N of Morgan's Point would be at the greatest risk.
- > Expecting the risk for reduced visibility to lift after 9 AM CT.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for today.

Wind: Winds out of the N/NNW gradually shift clockwise through the AM and settle out of the SE by 12 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts through 3 PM. Winds then gradually increase to 8-13 kts throughout the rest of the PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: High 80s/Near 90 F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F.

Visibility: Low end patchy fog risk Wed AM. See visibility slide for more detail.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers/storms will work into the area as early as 9 AM CT THU and will continue throughout the rest of the day. Chances to become more widespread after 6-7 PM. Main risks to be wind gusts of 30-40+ kts, lightning, and hail.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the day THU. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 5-10 kts through 10 AM before increasing to 11-16 kts the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 10-15 kts through 10 AM before gradually increasing to 19-24 kts by 1 PM. Non-T-Storm Gusts may reach 28-33 kts at times S of Morgan's Point after 10 AM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F S of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for THU, however visibilities can be reduced under heavy downpours


Precip: Scattered showers and storms will continue through 7 AM CT FRI before dry conditions the rest of the day

Wind: Winds to become variable just after midnight before settling out of the N/NW by 7 AM. Winds become variable once again after 7 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts for the day Friday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 19-24 kts quickly decrease to 10-15 kts by 6 AM then 5-10 kts after 11 AM.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low/Mid 80s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating a fog risk for FRI.

Wind Speed 2 PM CT












Next 7 Day Total Precipitation





8-14 Day Temperature Departure

- Next round of scattered rain chances will be around starting THU and will last into the weekend. The heaviest risk favored to sit just north or stations. Temps are expected to be seasonable for the week 1 timeframe.
- Below normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps are expected to be above normal.
- ➤ Below normal chances for precipitation are favored in the weeks ¾ timeframe. Temperatures expected to be much above normal for the weeks 3 and 4 timeframe.
