



American Model Next 10 Days - Tropical Tracks




Monitoring a tropical disturbance with the potential to become a Tropical Depression in the SW Gulf of Mexico between 6/17 - 6/20

As of FRI AM, direct impact with Houston is not favored. Periods of moderate/heavy rain and higher seas will be possible during that timeframe.



Possible Tropical Storm Development 6/17 - 6/20












Confidence



- Watching for a low-end patchy fog risk Friday morning between 4 AM − 9 AM. Best timeframe likely between 5 - 7 AM
- ➤ Visibility within this timeframe could drop to 2 4 miles. Cannot rule out a few isolated instances of visibility dropping to 1 2 miles.
- > Favoring this to be a risk for all stations N or Morgan's Point this morning.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions favored for today.

Wind: Expecting variable winds through 10AM, before shifting clockwise from the N through 4PM. After 4 PM, winds will settle out of the SE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 2-7 kts throughout the day on Friday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4-9 kts throughout the day before increasing to 6-11 kts after 4 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 90s F. S of Morgan's Point: Near 90 F.


Visibility: Watching a low-end risk for patchy fog development, reducing visibilities to 2 – 4 miles between ~4 AM – 9 AM.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions SAT.





Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day, aside from a brief window between 4 - 6 PM where scattered thunderstorms will be possible! Thunderstorm wind gusts of 30-35 kts possible along with hail and lightning.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE/E throughout the day Sunday. N of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds at 5 – 10 kts throughout 11AM before increasing to 10-15 kts for the rest of the evening. S of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds 11 – 16 kts through 4PM, before winds increase to 15-20 kts for the rest of the day o










