

European Model Next 10 Days - Tropical Tracks




Monitoring a tropical disturbance with the potential to become a Tropical Depression in the SW Gulf of Mexico between 6/18 - 6/21

Possible Tropical Storm Development 6/18 - 6/21








The highest waves are favored to arrive around 4 AM WED and continue through 4 AM THU. Over this time frame, favored wave heights are ~8 - 10ft at station 11/12 and the Boarding Station. An occasional 11 ft wave around the Boarding Station cannot be ruled out.

Wave heights very slowly recede across THU. Heights are currently anticipated to drop below 6 ft threshold around 7 AM FRI.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers and storms are expected to continue throughout much of the day today, tapering off after 11 PM. A few storms have the potential to become strong to locally severe with lightning, isolated hail, downpours and gusts of 35-45+ MPH.

Wind: Winds will remain out of the SE today. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8-13 kts for the remainder of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18-23 kts through ~6 PM, then winds will increase to 23-28 kts. A few non-storm gusts of 25-30kts can't be ruled out for stations S of Morgan's Point throughout the afternoon.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: Favoring dry conditions through 10 AM TUE before scattered to widespread showers/thunderstorms work into the area. These chances will continue into the PM hours. Main risks with thunderstorms will be lightning, hail and strong wind gusts (details below).

Wind: Winds will be out of the southeast through 10 AM before shifting to out of the east. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 8-13 kts through 10 AM before increasing to 12-17 kts. Thunderstorm-related wind gusts of 24-29 kts will be possible after 10 AM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18-23 kts through 10 AM before increasing to 26-31 kts for the remainder of the day. Thunderstorm-related wind gusts of 35-40 kts will be possible after 10 AM.







Thunderstorm-related wind gusts of 24-29 kts in play throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds at 26-31 kts throughout the entire day. Thunderstorm-related wind gusts of 35-40 kts in play throughout the day





Wind Speed 11 AM CT













Next 7 Day Total Precipitation



8-14 Day Temperature Departure





8-14 Day % of Average Precip.
