

Monitoring the potential for the formation of a Tropical Depression in the far SW portion of the Gulf of Mexico between 6/22 - 6/23






Significant Wave Height Image

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered showers/thunderstorms (40%) will continue for all stations through 3PM before chances decrease to 10% for the remainder of the evening. Isolated lightning strikes can be possible with storms!

Wind: Winds will be out of the east through the day before shifting out of the SE by 4 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 6-10 kts throughout the day decreasing slightly to 4-7 kts by 8 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 11-18 kts through 3PM before slightly decreasing to 10-15 kts for the rest of the day. Gusts up to 20-25 kts will be possible for all stations.


Wave Heights: Wave heights will continue to decrease throughout the day today, dropping to below 6 ft by 7 AM and 4ft by 10PM.


Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for today, however reduced visibilities possible under heavier downpours.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions throughout the day on Saturday.

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/SE throughout the day WED. N of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds at 7 – 12 kts throughout the day before slightly decreasing to 4– 9 kts for the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds at 10-15 kts throughout the day






Precip: Favoring mostly dry conditions throughout the day on Sunday, aside from low-end shower/thunderstorm chances between 3 – 7 PM. Majority of activity favored to remain to the W.

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/SE through 10AM before wind become variable through 2PM. After 2 PM winds settle back out of the SE for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3-8kts throughout the day on Sunday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 7-12 kts throughout the day on Sunday.





High Temp Sunday




