Monitoring a tropical disturbance with the potential to become a Tropical Depression in the SW Gulf of Mexico through the 21st.


As of TUE PM, direct impact with Houston is not favored. Periods of moderate/heavy rain and higher seas will be possible during that timeframe.



Wave heights of 6-8 ft will continue to increase throughout WED.

The highest waves are favored to arrive around 10 AM WED and continue through 7 AM THU. Over this time frame, favored wave heights are ~9-11 ft at station 11/12 and the Boarding Station. An occasional 11-12 ft wave around the Boarding Station cannot be ruled out.

Wave heights very slowly recede across THU. Heights are currently anticipated to drop below 6 ft threshold around 4 AM FRI.

### **Forecast Discussion**

Precip: Widespread showers/thunderstorms continue into the AM hours. Showers and thunderstorms will become more scattered in nature by 12 PM, where they will persist throughout the remainder of the evening. Main risks with thunderstorms will be lightning, hail and strong wind gusts (details below).

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/ESE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds at 12-17 kts throughout Wednesday. Thunderstorm-related wind gusts of 28-33 kts will be possible throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds at 29-35 kts throughout the entire day (Locally higher wins of 37 kts near the Boarding Station). Thunderstorm-related wind gusts of 40-45 kts in play throughout the day


Wave Heights: Wave heights will continue to increasing, reaching 9-11 ft by 10 AM CT for Stations 11/12 and the Boarding Station (an occasional 11-12 wave cannot be ruled out).


Visibility: Not favoring any fog concerns for today, however reduced visibilities possible under heavier downpours.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Scattered rain/storms to continue throughout the day on THU (20%). A few storms have the potential to produce wind gusts of 30-40 kts.

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/SE throughout the day THU. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 9-14 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 25-30 kts through 4 PM before decreasing to 22-26 kts through the rest of the day. Non-thunderstorm wind gusts of 28-33 kts will be possible S of Morgan's Point throughout the day and N of Morgan's Point from 10 AM to 6 PM.


Wave Heights: Wave heights of 9-11 ft will continue for Stations 11/12 and the Boarding Station through ~7 AM CT THU. After 7 AM, wave heights will gradually decrease, however remain above 6 ft throughout all of THU.


**Visibility:** Not anticipating any fog concerns for Thursday, however reduced visibilities possible under heavier downpours.

### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Scattered showers and thunderstorms (30%) will continue across the area through 6 PM before becoming rather hit/miss (10%) the rest of the evening.

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/SE throughout FRI. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 5-10 kts throughout the day with a slight increase to 8-13 kts from 12-6 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds at 18-23 kts for the entire day FRI. Gusts ranging from 19-24 kts possible from 11 AM to 7 PM at all stations.


Wave Heights: Wave heights be at 6-7 ft through 4 AM CT FRI. After 4 AM, wave heights will reach under 6 ft and remaining there as they decrease the rest of the day.


Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for FRI, however reduced visibilities possible under heavier downpours.

Wind Speed: 3 PM CT













#### Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




**Next 7 Day Total Precipitation** 




8-14 Day Temperature Departure





8-14 Day % of Average Precip.

- Above normal precipitation chances are at play during the week 2 timeframe. Temps are expected to be near normal for week 2.
- Above normal chances for precipitation and near normal temperatures are favored in the weeks 3/4 timeframe.
