



BOARDING STATION MAIN TAKEAWAYS

Wind Direction: Consistently out of the SE SUN through MON PM, before coming out of the S by 6PM MON night, and then out of the SW all day TUE.

Wind Timing: Highest winds likely come 7AM MON to 6 PM MON.

Wind Speed Max: 33-38 knots possible.

Wind Gust Max: 45-55 knots possible.

Wave Heights: Peak wave heights of 6-8 feet will be possible at the boarding station between 1 AM MON and 1 AM TUE.




NOTES: As of Sat Evening, Tropical Storm Beryl has entered the Gulf of Mexico and will gradually intensify back into a hurricane. This storm will push WNW across the Gulf through MON AM, where it will likely make landfall near Corpus Christi. Although slight Northeast trends with the storm track are possible, not anticipating direct landfall in Houston/Galveston at this time. Wave heights expected to be above 6 ft on Monday with winds above 34+ kt threshold.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A few isolated bands of scattered showers/storms from Beryl will be possible in the AM to early PM hours, with more scattered to widespread rains likely not working in until after 6 PM. **Tornadoes will be possible with any strong storms!**

Wind: Winds will be out SE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 3 – 8 kts through the AM, increasing to 8– 13 kts after 12 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Favoring winds 10-15 kts through 8 AM, then winds increase to 20 - 25 kts by 11 AM, remaining there the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 25-35 kts S of Morgan's Point will be possible after 7 PM CT


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 80s F.


Visibility: Fog is not favored for today however heavier downpours can result in reduced visibilities.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Anticipating widespread moderate/heavy rain associated with Tropical Storm Beryl to work through the area throughout MON. See tropical slide(s) above for more in on exact timing/impacts related to Beryl.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE through ~6 PM before shifting to being out of the South. N of Morgan's Point: Winds start at 13-18 kts and gradually increasing throughout the day. Wind peak at 25-35 kts from 2-8 PM CT, gradually calming afterwards. S of Morgan's Point: Winds begin at 25-30 kts, gradually increasing to 33-38 kts by 1 PM. Winds continue at this rate through ~7 PM CT before gradually decreasing. Wind gusts of 30-35+ kts will be prevalent at ALL STATIONS MON. Peak gusts of 45-55 knots will be possible at the Boarding Station.





Forecast Discussion


Precip: A few bands of scattered showers/storms will linger behind Tropical Storm Beryl throughout the day on Tuesday. Main risks with thunderstorms will be lightning and 20-25 kt gusts.

Wind: Winds remain out of the SW throughout Tuesday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds begin the day at 8-13 kts and will be on a decline through 6 AM, settling at 4-9 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds begin the day at 20-25 kts and will be on a gradual decline through 9 AM, settling at 6-11 kts. Gusts of 20-25 kts will be possible for all stations with scattered thunderstorms




Visibility: Fog is not favored for Tuesday however heavier downpours can result in reduced visibilities.









Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation




8-14 Day Temperature Departure

- ➤ Temps are expected to be slightly above normal for the week 1 timeframe. Heavy Rainfall associated with Tropical Storm Beryl will work through MON/TUE.
- Models are favoring slightly below normal precipitation for the week 2 timeframe. Near normal temperatures are favored for week 2.
- ➤ Above normal chances for precipitation and near normal temperatures are favored in the weeks 3/4 timeframe.
