European Model Next 10 Days - Tropical Tracks



Areas in Orange should be ready / monitor potential into next week. Areas likely at a heavy rainfall risk regardless of development




Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)


Precip: Favoring mostly dry conditions outside of a stray light shower from 10 AM through 5 PM today


Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 4 - 9 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 8-13 kts for the majority of the day outside of a brief calming to 4-9 kts from 1-5 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 80s F.

Visibility: Isolated fog possible for Stations N of Morgan's Point, however coverage favored to remain N of all stations. Visibilities will also not reach below 3 miles.



Precip: Favoring mostly dry conditions outside of isolated showers from 10 AM to 5 PM MON.

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE through the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3-8 kts throughout all of Monday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 6-11 kts through 11 AM before calming to 4-9 kts the rest of the day


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 90s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid/Upper 80s F.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Scattered (30-40%) light showers in play for all Stations between 3 – 8 AM. A midday dry spell occurs before scattered to widespread (60-70%) showers and storms return between 3 – 7 PM. Storms will hold risks for lightning and wind gusts of 20-25 kts.

Wind: Winds will be variable through 5 PM, settling out of the SE after that time. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be sustained at 3-8 kts throughout Tuesday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be sustained at 5-10 kts through Tuesday. Non-Thunderstorm wind gusts can reach 15-20 kts.








High Temps Tuesday

Houston Pilots: 9/22/24





- Temps are expected to be above normal for the week 1 timeframe. Favoring mostly dry conditions to start the week before an increase in chances late week 1
- Near normal temperatures are favored for week 2. Confidence is low on precip chances due to tropical storm chances.
- Below normal temperatures and much below normal precipitation chances are expected for the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
