



1 AM CT SAT




We're monitoring the risk of increasing wave heights with the tropical system pushing into the Gulf this weekend, though there is lower confidence.

Timeframe to watch for peak wave heights of 3+ feet will be 7 PM Saturday – 7 AM Monday.

European Model Next 10 Days - Tropical Tracks



Favoring a Tropical System to continue to work through the E Caribbean. At this time, we are not favoring this system to develop into a tropical storm/hurricane.

Any development would likely not occur until mid next week, with the potential for additional scattered showers/storms and elevated gusts only.


Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)


Precip: Widespread rain showers/storms will continue through 5 PM. Showers/storms will become more scattered in nature after then but will continue through the rest of the night. A few stronger gusts of up to 30kts will be possible.


Wind: Winds will be out of the NE through the remainder of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 7 - 12 kts for the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 13 - 18 kts with occasional non-thunderstorm gusts up to 25 kts at the Boarding Station.


Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid to Upper 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F.


Visibility: Not anticipating any concerns for today, outside of heavier downpours reducing visibilities to less than 3 miles.


Precip: Isolated to scattered chances for showers and storms throughout the day Friday before clearing out by 7 PM. Dry conditions are then favored for the remainder of the night.


Wind: Winds will be out of the NE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be sustained 7 - 12 kts throughout Friday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be sustained at 14 – 18 kts, with gusts of 18 – 25 kts possible for all Stations.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to mid 80s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for Friday.


Precip: A few lingering, light showers through 3AM can't be ruled out, but at this time we are finally beginning to favor dry conditions for most of the day!


Wind: Winds will be generally out of the N/NE for the entire day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds at 6 – 12 kts for the entire day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 14 - 20 kts throughout the day. Non-thunderstorm wind gusts of 25 kts will be possible for stations S of 11/12.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 80s F.

Precip Image: 11 AM CT








High Temps Saturday
