Forecast Made: Thursday, September 12, 2024



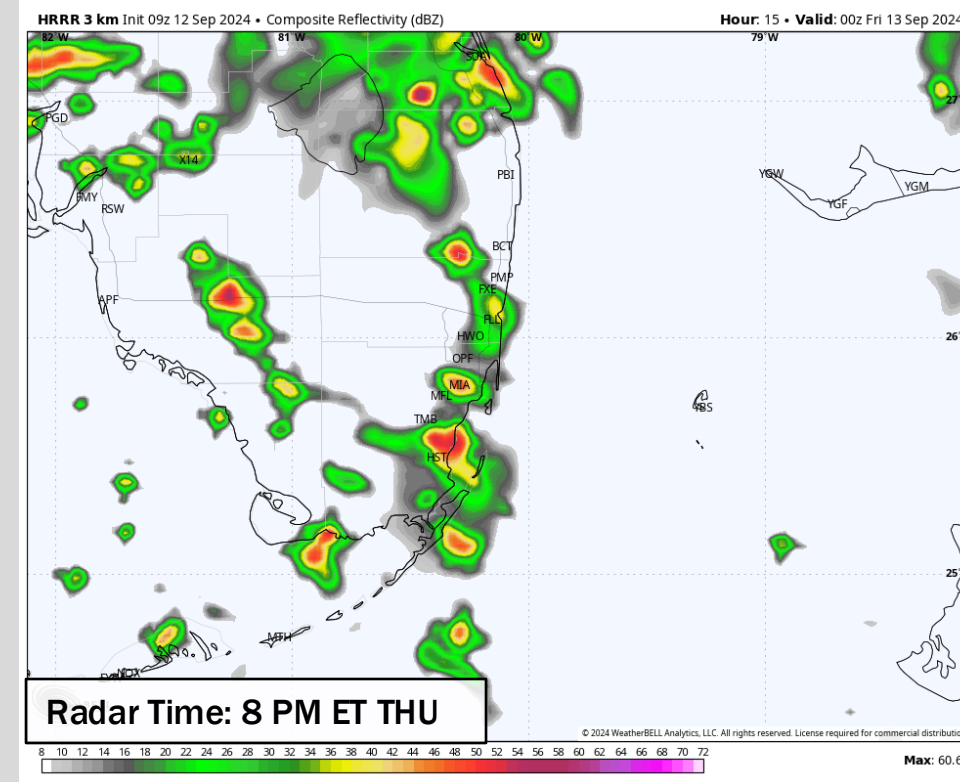
Forecast Notes for Thursday (9/12/24)

8 AM–12 PM: Mostly dry time favored with a near ~10% chance for showers/ storms associated with sea breeze/ outflow of showers/ storms to the east. Risk for lightning is low but non-zero, mainly after 10 AM.

12-7 PM: Coverage is expected to increase though the afternoon with a pop-up type of storm possible at any point. From about 12 – 2 PM, chances are closer to 20% before shooting up to 60% from 3 – 7 PM. Locally heavy downpours/ torrential rain, lightning, wind gusts of 40+ MPH and a low-end risk for hail will be possible under the heaviest cells. These will likely be “slow movers” with chaotic behavior this afternoon/ early evening.

8 PM – 12 AM: Coverage is expected to quickly drop off by 8 – 9 PM. While a more isolated cell/ storm (low end risk for lightning/ heavy downpour) will be possible, **mostly dry time is expected for the game tonight.** Overall chances drop from 40% by 8 PM to 20% by 9 PM. After 9 PM chances drop to 10%.

- High Temperatures THU afternoon around ~90 F.
- Kickoff: near 82 F
- By 11 PM: near 81 F

Heat Index Notes

- Values of 100 – 103 from 11 AM – 4 PM.
- Kickoff: near 91 - 93 F
- By 11 PM: ~87 F

Additional Notes

Mostly dry conditions are expected for the game – however the radar will likely be active this afternoon around the Miami area.
