Forecast Made: Sunday, October 6, 2024



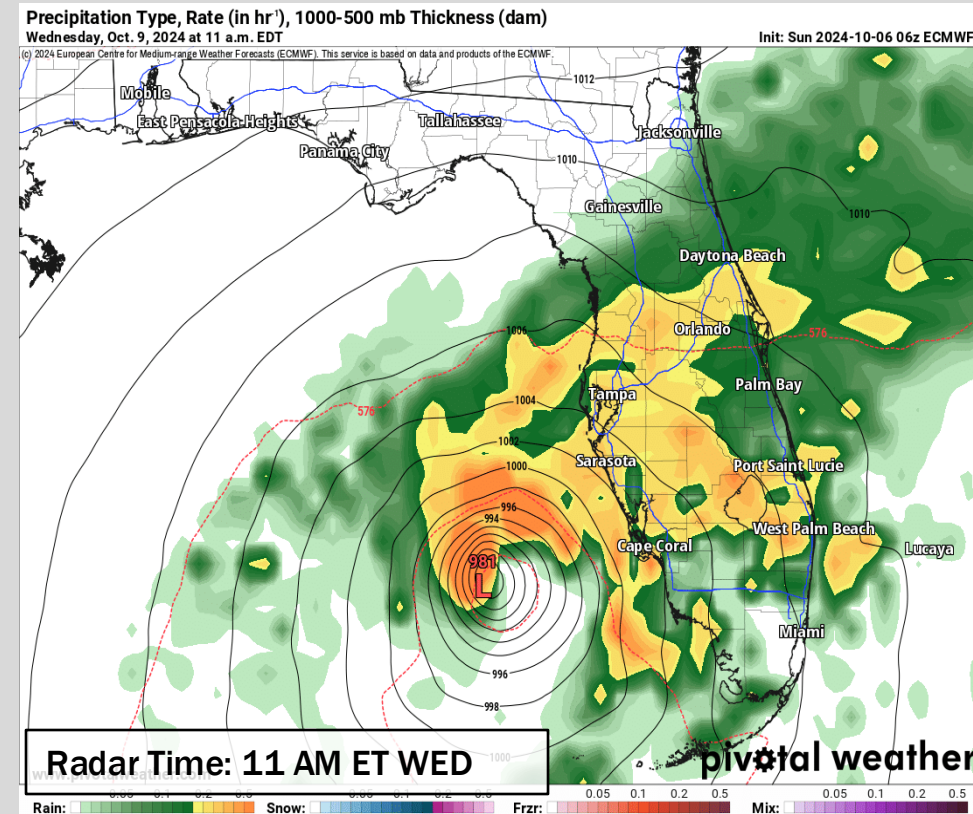
Forecast Notes For TUE-THU (10/8 – 10/10)

2 AM TUE – 5 AM WED: Outer bands of Future Hurricane Milton will work in from the E/SE in a scattered fashion (30-40%). Main risks will be lightning and moderate to heavier downpours with any cells (still dry time mixed in). Isolated wind gusts of 30-40 MPH under strongest storms.

5 AM WED – 8 PM WED: Coverage expected to become more widespread in the 60-70% range (heaviest rain and strongest impacts expected to remain north of Miami area). Main risks will be increased wind gusts of 45-55 MPH over this period.

8 PM WED – 12 PM THU: Rain will become more hit/miss (10-20% as Milton works further east the rest of WED PM and into THU. Wind gusts of 30+ MPH will be possible through 12 PM THU.

Wind Notes

Sustained winds of 22-27 MPH will be possible and wind gusts of 45-55 MP possible WED (greatest risk 10 AM to 5 PM)

Storm Surge Notes

Not favoring storm surge threats for the Miami area at this distance.

Additional Notes

Continuing to watch for southerly trends in the data, which would allow for stronger gusts for WED.
