


NOTES:



With the increased winds on Thursday, wave heights are anticipated to reach 4-5 ft at the Boarding Station by 4PM Thursday.

Wave heights reach 5 – 6ft by 6PM THU and continue there through ~12PM Friday, then decrease to 4-5ft throughout the remainder of Friday.


Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)

Precip: Favoring dry conditions for remainder of the day.




Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 30s F. S of Morgan's Point: Lower to mid 40s F.




Precip: Favoring scattered (50%) showers to begin at 8 AM for all Stations, with coverage becoming widespread (80-90%) after 12 PM. Thunderstorms are not favored, but strong winds and wind gusts will accompany this system.


Wind: Winds will be out of the E/NE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3 – 8 kts through 3PM, increasing to 13 – 18 kts after that time. Wind gusts of 25 – 30 kts in play for Stations N of Morgan's Point after 4 PM as well. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 13 – 18 kts through 10 AM, steadily increasing through the evening before settling at 25 – 30 kts after 6 PM. Wind gusts of 20-25 kts in play S of Morgan's Point through 12 PM, gradually increasing to 35 – 40 kts by ~6 PM THU. Sustained winds may briefly reach 34+ kts and gusts may briefly reach 45+ kts at the Boarding Station, 11/12


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Lower 50s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 40s to upper 50s F.

Visibility: Not anticipating any fog concerns for Thursday, but visibilities will be reduced below 2 miles under heavy downpours after 6PM.

Forecast Discussion

1 PM CT

Precip: Favoring widespread showers and downpours (100%) from 12AM – 6AM, before chances become more scattered (50%) and lighter through 10AM. After this point, favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds will slowly rotate from the NE to the NW through the entire course of Friday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 8 - 13 kts throughout all of Friday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 17 - 22 kts for all of Friday. Gusts of up to 20 – 25 kts will be in play for all Stations through the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 40s F. S of Morgan's Point: Lower to upper 40s F.

Visibility: No fog concerns for Friday, however visibilities may be reduced to 2-4 miles due to heavy downpours in the AM.

Precip Image: 2 AM CT








High Temps Friday

- Temps are expected to be much below normal for the week 1 timeframe. Rain favored late week and into the weekend and then drier conditions in play for the start of next week.
- > Below normal temperatures and above normal rainfall are expected for week 2.
- > Above normal temperatures and near normal precipitation chances are expected for the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
