





- Watching for hazy conditions / potential patchy fog development starting within GALV. Bay by 10 PM Friday.
- We are watching for visibilities to possibly reduce to 2 4miles for stations S. of Morgan's Point. Although the better risk may be situated in the E portions of the bay, isolated pockets of dense fog with <1 mile visibility cannot be ruled out for Stations S. of Morgan's Point, especially from 11 PM FRI to 2 AM SAT.
- Fog is favored to clear out by 6 AM SAT as a weak front passes through.


Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)


Precip: Light showers will be possible for stations N of Morgan's Point through 3 PM, then only pockets of hit and miss drizzle favored for the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds this afternoon are out of the S. After 7 PM, winds will shift out of the SW. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 13 - 18 kts through 5 PM then will decrease to 5 – 10 kts the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 13 – 18 kts through the rest of the PM. Gusts of 23 – 28 kts will be possible for all Stations this PM.

Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 50s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 50s F.

Visibility: Anticipating clear conditions for much of the PM with patchy fog beginning after 10 PM continuing into SAT AM. See visibility slide.


Precip: Isolated (20%) light rain showers will be possible from 6 AM – 9 AM CT for all stations. Favoring dry conditions then for the rest of the day.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SW through 9 AM before shifting out of the NW for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 7 - 12 kts for all of Saturday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 10 – 15 kts for all of Saturday. Gusts of 25 – 30 kts will be in play for all Stations through noon. After 12 PM, only the Boarding Station will be at risk for gusts of 20 - 25 kts.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low to mid-60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.

Visibility: Watching for a patchy fog risk ahead of the front late FRI into early Saturday morning. Visibility impacts will be limited however the threat is nonzero. See visibility slide for additional details.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Sunday.


Wind: Winds will be generally out of the N throughout Sunday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 7 - 12 kts through 7 PM before decreasing to 2 – 7 kts for the rest of Sunday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 18 - 23 kts throughout Sunday.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid-40s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 40s F.

Visibility: Not favoring any fog concerns for Sunday.



Keeping an eye on late MON PM → mid TUE PM for scattered to widespread wintry mix potential.

Graphic to the left is just a snapshot representing where the greatest risk for snowfall may occur. Sleet, graupel and rain are anticipated to "mix in", especially for areas S of Houston Metro, cutting down snow totals realized at the surface. Adjustments to this forecast can be expected.


That said, slick spots and temperatures below 32 F will be the main risks to monitor with this wintry threat.

Confidence on exact precip type, exact totals and exact timing is low at this time. Additional updates to come as we fine tune details.

Update as of 1/17

Houston Pilots: 1/17/25





- Temps are expected to be much below normal for the week 1 timeframe. Dry conditions favored until the start of next week where there is a risk for wintry potential. Graphic displays liquid accumulation between rain/wintry mix.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal rainfall are expected for week 2.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal precipitation chances are expected for the weeks ³/₄ timeframe.
