- TIMEFRAME THREAT
 DISCUSSED

 Current 6 AM SAT Low-End
- We continue to watch for potential fog development, however, we now believe this to be a low-end threat with likely most seeing no impacts.
- However, with any fog able to form, visibilities can be reduced to 2 4 miles for stations S. of Morgan's Point. Although the better risk may be situated in the E portions of the bay, isolated pockets of dense fog with <1 mile visibility cannot be ruled out for Stations S. of Morgan's Point, especially from from now to 3 AM SAT.</p>
- Any fog that forms is favored to clear out by 6 AM SAT as a weak front passes through.



Houston Pilots Wind Chart







Forecast Discussion


Precip: Isolated (10%) light rain showers will be possible from 5 AM – 9 AM CT for the boarding station. Favoring dry conditions then for the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SW through 8 AM before shifting out of the NW for the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 7 - 12 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 10 - 15 kts through 7 PM before increasing to 13 - 18 kts for the rest of the day. Gusts of 25 - 30 kts will be in play for all Stations throughout the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low to 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.




Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Sunday.

Wind: Winds will be generally out of the N throughout Sunday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 9 - 14 kts through 6 PM before decreasing to 3 - 8 kts for the rest of Sunday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 20 - 25 kts throughout Sunday.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions Monday. However, shortly after midnight a mixture of snow / rain and potential ice will work in. Check next slide for more info.

Wind: Winds will generally but out of the NE/E throughout the day on Monday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 4 – 9 kts throughout Monday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 17 – 22 kts throughout Monday. Gusts of 20 – 25 kts will be possible for all Stations N or Morgan's Point, with 25-30 kts wind gusts being possible for Stations S of Morgan's Point.





Above Normal



Keeping an eye on late MON PM → mid TUE PM for scattered to widespread winter precip risks.

Graphic to the left is just a snapshot representing where the greatest risk for snowfall may occur. Sleet, ice pellets, and rain are anticipated to "mix in", especially for areas S of Houston Metro, cutting down snow totals realized at the surface.

Adjustments to this forecast can be expected.

That said, slick spots and temperatures below 32 F will be the main risks to monitor with this wintry threat.

Confidence on exact precip type, exact totals and exact timing is low at this time. Additional updates to come as we fine - tune details.











Next 7 Day Total Precipitation



8-14 Day Temperature Departure




8-14 Day % of Average Precip.
