



Wave heights are expected to increase to 4-5' for the Boarding Station after 3 PM on MON (1/20) and will peak at 6-7' by 12 AM TUE (1/21).

Wave heights will then gradually decrease back to 4-5' by midnight WED (1/22) and continue to decrease further into WED.

Snapshot of Potential Snowfall Totals "Falling From the Sky"




Below Normal

Keeping an eye on overnight MON→ mid TUE PM for scattered to widespread winter precip risks.

Generalized 2" - 3" of snowfall is expected to fall from the sky but will mix in with rain and sleet which will lower any accumulation at the surface.

Slick spots on roadways and temperatures below 32 F will be the main risks to monitor with this wintry threat.

Confidence on exact precip type, exact totals and exact timing is low at this time. Additional updates to come as we fine - tune details.






Precip: Favoring dry conditions for the rest of the day.

Wind: Winds will be out of the N throughout the remainder of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 10 - 15 kts through 6 PM before decreasing to 4 - 9 kts for the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 16 - 21 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts of 20 - 25 kts will be in play for Stations S of Morgan's Point for the rest of the day.





Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions through 11PM, before a mixture of snow / rain and potential ice will work in. Check Day 3 slide and Winter Weather Potential slide for more info.

Wind: Winds will generally but out of the E/NE throughout the day on Monday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 6 – 13 kts throughout Monday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 15 – 20 kts throughout Monday. Gusts of 15 – 25 kts will be possible for all Stations N of Morgan's Point, with 25-30 kts wind gusts being possible for Stations S of Morgan's Point.






Precip: A widespread mix of snow, ice pellets and rain will be in play for all Stations through 2 PM. See Winter Weather Potential slide for further details.

Wind: Winds will be out of the N/NE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 10 - 15 kts through 3 PM, decreasing to 3 - 8 kts after that time. Wind gusts of 20-25 kts in play through 3 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 25 - 30 kts sustained through 5 PM, decreasing to 8 - 13 kts after that time. Sustained winds will be able to reach 35 kts at times for the Boarding Station between 6 AM and 2 PM. Wind gusts of 40 - 45 kts in play through 2 PM, decreasing to 20 - 25 kts after that time.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 30s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 30s F. Favoring slick spots on roadways after 12AM TUE as winter precip moves in. Pavement impacts are possible throughout the course of the day.


Visibility: No fog concerns for Tuesday, however, pockets of reduced visibility will be possible under snow showers.

Wind Speed: 6 AM CT







