





Wave heights will then gradually decrease back to 4-5' by midnight WED (1/22) and continue to decrease further into WED.


# Winter Storm Update





An additional 0.25"-0.5" in slushy accumulations will be possible.

Temperatures warming to above 32 F after 12-1PM today will help to melt slushy snow accumulations.



- CURRENT RADAR (6 AM CT) Graphic represents favored "back edge" timing of the main show of winter weather.
- ✓ Favoring coverage becomes more scattered throughout the AM as activity gradually pushes SE.
- $\checkmark$  A slight increase in temps to above 32 F will help to melt slush nearing ~12-1 PM.

Generalized 2" – 3" of snowfall is expected to fall from the sky but will mix in with rain and sleet which will lower any accumulation at the surface.


Slick spots on roadways and temperatures below 32 F after 2 AM TUE will be the main risk to monitor with this wintry threat.

## **Reduced Visibility Forecast (WED)**






Watching for a lowend risk of reduced visibility to 1 – 3 miles WED AM. Main risk will be for Station's N of Morgan's Point.

The main timeframe to watch for this risk is as early as 2 AM WED AM, with the greatest risk between 3 – 6 AM.

Confidence is overall low for this threat, with fog to be localized in nature.

## **Reduced Visibility Forecast (THU)**






Watching for a lowend risk of reduced visibility to 1 – 3 miles WED AM. Main risk will be for Station's N of Morgan's Point.

The main timeframe to watch for this risk is as early as 12 AM WED AM, with the greatest risk between 3 – 6 AM.



### **Forecast Discussion**

**Precip:** A widespread mix of snow, ice pellets and rain will be in play for all Stations through 12 PM. See Winter Weather Potential slide for further details.


Wind: Winds will be out of the N/NE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 10 - 15 kts through 3 PM, decreasing to 3 - 8 kts after that time. Wind gusts of 20-25 kts in play through 3 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 25 - 30 kts sustained through 3 PM, decreasing to 8 - 13 kts after that time. Sustained winds will be able to reach 35 kts at times for the Boarding Station between 3 AM and 12 PM. Wind gusts of 40 - 45 kts in play through 12 PM for Station 51/52 down to the Boarding Station, decreasing to 20 - 25 kts through 6 PM.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 30s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 30s F. Favoring slick spots on roadways after 2AM TUE as wintry precip moves in. Pavement impacts are possible throughout the course of the day.

Visibility: No fog concerns for today, however, pockets of reduced visibility will be possible under snow showers.




**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions for Wednesday.


Wind: Winds will be out of the N/NNE through 5 AM, shifting clockwise to be out of the SE by 10 AM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 2 - 7 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will start at 8 - 13 kts and gradually decrease through the morning, settling at 4 – 9 kts by 8 AM and remaining at that clip for the rest of the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 30s to low 40s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to mid 40s F.

Visibility: Monitoring a low-end, patchy, non-sea fog risk for Stations N of Morgan's Point through 8 AM Wednesday. See Reduced Visibility Forecast slide for more info.


Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Thursday.


Wind: Winds will shift out of the NE shortly after midnight and remain out of that direction throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3 – 8 kts throughout the day Thursday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 – 13 kts throughout the day Thursday. Gusts of 15 – 25 kts will be possible for all Stations S of Morgan's Point throughout the day.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 40s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 40s F.

Visibility: Patchy non-sea fog in play for Stations N of Morgan's Point through 8 AM Thursday. Subfreezing AM temperatures may result in the formation of ice on surfaces. See Reduced Visibility Forecast slide for more info.



# Houston Pilots: 1/21/25





- Temps are expected to be much below normal for the week 1 timeframe. Favoring precipitation early in the week, with a drier latter half of the week. Graphic displays liquid accumulation between rain/wintry mix.
- > Near normal temperatures and above normal rainfall are expected for week 2.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal precipitation chances are expected for the weeks <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> timeframe.
