

- Dense sea fog continues to be the main risk for all stations through Thursday morning, with at least a patchy risk continuing through the afternoon.
- We are currently in Yankee Port conditions as wave heights are anticipated to reach 6 ft by 12PM THU. See wave height slide for more information!





# **Wave Height Forecast Update**







Wave heights at the Boarding Station are expected to increase THU AM, reaching 6' by 12PM THU.

Modeled wave height images may be slightly underdone, so we are not completely ruling out a few 6' waves at the Boarding Station.

By 10AM FRI, we are favoring wave heights to be at or below 4ft.








### Confidence



- Widespread fog is expected to continue, especially for stations S of Morgan's Point. Reduced visibilities of less than 0.5 miles will be favored for locations S of Morgan's point through at least 6AM.
- For locations N of Morgan's point, fog will continue to be patchier in nature through ~10PM with reduced visibilities of 1-2 miles likely. Visibility of less than 0.5 miles can't be ruled out but favoring best potential for this to occur beyond 10PM, in addition to coverage likely becoming more widespread.
- Confidence is still below normal in terms of coverage/how dense fog will be for Stations N. of Morgan's Point from 10PM – 6AM. Nevertheless, a few intermittent breaks in fog coverage will be possible, although they will be short lived.










### Confidence



- Beyond 6AM, we are favoring fog to become patchier for stations N of Morgan's Point, with reduced visibilities 1-2 miles to continue through ~10AM. Risk to this forecast is fog exiting earlier due to light showers pushing in from the west.
- For stations S of Morgan's Point, we are now favoring pockets of patchy dense fog (<0.5 miles) to continue through at least 3PM ahead of the front. Widespread fog can remain possible for the boarding station with little to no breaks through this time period.
- Confidence remains lowest in risks beyond 3PM as a storm front will likely limit any additional fog potential. However, we need to watch for a risk where timing for the boarding station may need to be extended.

# **Houston Pilots Wind Chart**







Precip: After 5PM, a few isolated showers/drizzles (20%) will be possible, mainly for stations N of 11/12.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE throughout the rest of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 4 - 9 kts for the remainder of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 - 13 kts for the remainder of the day.


**Low Temps:** N of Morgan's Point: Lower 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 50s F.



### **Forecast Discussion**


Precip: Favoring rain showers to move in after 11AM and linger through 9PM. After 2PM, a few strong storms, will be possible through ~8PM as the front pushes through. Isolated hail and gusts of up to 45kts will be possible!

Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SE through 4 PM, shifting clockwise out of the W/SW by 7 PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 10 - 15 kts decreasing to 2 - 7 kts after 5 PM. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be 10 - 15 kts through 3 AM, increasing to 18 - 23 kts after that time, then decreasing to 7 - 12 kts after 7 PM. Non-Thunderstorm wind gusts of 20 - 25 kts in play for all Stations from 12AM to 6PM. From 10AM to 4PM Non-Thunderstorm wind gusts will increase to up to 30 kts for all Stations.







**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions for Friday



S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3 – 8 kts through the day with a brief increase in winds of 8 - 13 kts from 9AM to 5PM.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s to lower 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Low to Mid 60s F.



















- > Temps are expected to be above normal for the week ahead. Favoring scattered rain showers throughout the week, with drier conditions by the weekend/start of next week.
