S of Morgan's Point: Widespread, dense sea fog will likely continue through ~6AM before slowly "breaking up" and becoming patchier due to winds being more out of the SW. Visibilities of less than 1 mile favored.


Stations N. of Morgan's Point, Intermittent periods of fog with visibilities of 1-3 miles can't be ruled out through 6AM, but favoring majority of fog to stay south towards Morgan's Point.

Confidence has slightly increased that a fog will clear out from all stations N of from 6AM through 9AM, as SSW winds "push" fog into E. portions of the Bay. See more on this on slide below.



Outside of patchy fog throughout the day for 11/12 and the Boarding Stations (visibilities less than 2 miles at times), fog will likely not build back in until after 4PM.


Stations S of Morgan's Point will see widespread, dense fog slowly build back in from 4PM – 8PM, with visibilities of less than 2 miles favored.

Stations N of Morgan's: Patchy fog with visibilities of 1-3 miles can't be ruled out from 10PM SAT – 3AM SUN.

All fog will begin to receded after 6AM SUN as winds shift more out of the east. Confidence is low on exact exit time.


Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)

Precip: Expecting a few isolated pockets of mist to be possible for Station 11/12 and the Boarding Station through 11AM while all other stations remain dry. 10% chances for this period.


Wind: Winds will be out of the S/SW throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 – 12 kts throughout the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 5 – 10 kts for day. Infrequent gusts may reach 20 kts through 4PM for all Stations.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Low 80s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F to lower 70s F.


Visibility: Monitoring for at least a continued patchy sea fog risks for all Stations today.




Precip: Favoring a 20% chance of light showers from 10AM – 3PM for Sunday.


Wind: Winds will be out of the S / SE for Sunday, outside of a period of variable winds from 10AM – 4PM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 4 – 9 kts through all of Sunday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 5 – 8 kts for all of Sunday.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 70s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F.

Visibility: Watching for a sea fog threat for all Stations throughout SUN. Confidence is lower on when exactly the front will pass through, allowing for the fog threats to recede.


Precip: Favoring 10% chances of drizzle / mist for all stations between 2AM – 10AM on Monday.


Wind: Winds will be out of the ESE / SE for all of Monday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 3 – 7 kts for all of Monday. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 – 12 kts for all of Monday.

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F.

Visibility: Monitoring patchy sea fog risks, although confidence in exact timing is very low at present.


