





Expecting visibility to be reduced to 1 - 2 miles at times with a few pockets of fog reducing visibility to 0.5 mile or less.


After 4PM, we are expecting more dense, widespread fog to form for Stations S. of Morgan's Point. See next slide for details.



Watching for a dense sea fog risk reducing visibility for Stations S. of Morgan's Point throughout the day Monday.


Dense sea fog risks expected to expand to Stations


Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)

High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Near 80 F. S of Morgan's Point: Mid to upper 60s F.




Precip: Very isolated light showers in play for Stations N of Morgan's Point between 12 – 5 PM.




