


Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Scattered light showers will be possible through ~11PM. Storms will be possible after 4PM, with a few strong to potentially severe storms will be possible with the main risks being lightning and large hail from 6PM to 10PM.

Wind: Winds will be out of the SE through 9PM. After that time, winds become variable in direction. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 5 - 10 kts throughout the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 13 - 18 kts for the rest of the PM. Non-thunderstorm wind gusts of 20 - 25kts will be possible for all Stations throughout the day, with wind gusts up to 28 kts possible for Stations S. of Morgan's through 6PM.






Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions for Wednesday.

Wind: Winds will be out of the N/NE throughout the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 – 13 kts through the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 22 – 27 kts through 9 AM, decreasing to 15 – 20 kts after that time. Wind gusts of 30-35 kts in play for all Stations through 11 AM, decreasing to 20-25 kts for the rest of the day. Wind gusts at the Boarding Station may remain at up to 30 kts through the entire day.







Gusts up to 20 kts will be possible at all Stations throughout the day, with gusts of 25-30 kts in play for Stations S of Morgan's Point through 11AM.




