



Houston Pilots Visibility Report



CURRENT VISIBILITY (12:45 PM)



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Visibility has improved across all Stations, excluding the Boarding Station. Patchy areas of visibilities of 1 - 2 miles will still be possible, though dense fog has cleared up for the time-being.

Max: 10.10 • Min: 0.24

Past 3PM, expecting patchy dense fog to return for Stations S. of 51/52, with visibilities of 1 - 2 miles.

By 6PM, favoring Stations S. of Morgan's Point to see widespread fog with visibilities less than 1 mile and areas less than 0.5-mile.

For Stations N. of Morgan's Point, not favoring any fog impacts through 9PM, with sea-fog risks entering after then.


Confidence is lower on when exactly fog will start to build back in.




From 10AM to 6PM, favoring fog for Stations N. of Morgan's Point to come and go.

Houston Pilots Visibility Chart (miles)




Low Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 60s F. S of Morgan's Point: Upper 50s to low 60s F.






High Temps Wednesday
