

IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES (as of 1:45 PM ET, 04/15/2025):

- ✓ Scattered drizzle / light showers are continuing to push W to E through Pittsburgh. By 2–3 PM, we need to watch for scattered showers/storms capable of moderate to briefly heavy rain, lightning and very isolated hail risks with the greatest coverage (70%) lasting until 4 PM. From 4 PM through the rest of the PM, scattered coverage will decrease (40%) and become light to briefly moderate at times. Additional totals throughout the day could amount to 0.05 0.1" with locally heavier amounts of 0.2" under a downpour.
- ✓ Scattered showers (30%) will continue into the AM WED. Marginal temps may allow for some snow to mix in early in the AM however surface temps will be too warm for accumulation
- ✓ Anticipating high temps to reach the low 50s F this afternoon, low temps will reach the mid 30s F WED AM
- ✓ Winds have increased to 20–25 MPH sustained out of the WNW with gusts reaching 40–50 MPH under stronger storms. By 6 PM, winds decrease to 13–18 MPH with gusts up to 35 MPH.

- Grounds will be wet from scattered rain/snow showers WED AM.
