

Current Weather Alerts:

Temperatures:

High temps today will reach the low 80s F. Lows will drop into the low to mid 60s F. Wind/Clouds:

Sunny skies favored through most of the day, by 6 PM clouds build in with storms. Winds will pick up to 13-18 MPH after 10 AM. Non-storm gusts may reach 30 MPH. Wind Direction:

Winds will be blowing from HP to CF this AM, then after 1 PM and for the remainder of the day, will be from HP to LF (aside from variability in storms).

Dry conditions expected through much of the day. Between 6 – 9 PM, scattered storms will push into Chicago. A few of these storms may be locally severe with gusts of 40 - 60 MPH, brief heavy downpours and an isolated risk for hail.

Rain Totals:

Today's Precipitation Chances:

Favoring rainfall totals of 0.1 – 0.5" from this evenings storms. At this time, anticipating locally heavier amount of 0.7 to remain S of Chicago.

Dew/Frost:

Not anticipating dew SAT AM and elevated sustained winds may help to dry up the field from FRI PM rains.










Precip Totals: Next 5 Days
