Temperatures:

High temperatures will get up to the low 80s, and temperatures will drop to the low 70s after sunset.

Wind/Clouds:

Mostly sunny conditions are favored today, with increasing cloud cover in the overnight with the increasing rain chances.

Winds will be sustained at 9 - 13 MPH today with non-thunderstorm gusts up to 15 MPH.

Wind Direction:

Winds will be from CF to the HP through 5 PM and then the wind shifts to blow from RF to the 3B line for the rest of the day.

Chicago should remain dry throughout most of the day, however there is a chance for rain in the evening and into the overnight from 8 PM today - 4 AM tomorrow. The timeframe with the highest chance of showers is from 12 AM to 4 AM Friday. The heavier cells are favored to trend N and W of Wrigley.

Rain Totals:

A range of 0.05 - 0.1" is likely, but some local areas N of Wrigley could see up to an inch if hit with a heavy cell.

Dew/Fog:

Grounds will be wet FRI AM.

Temperatures:

High temperatures will increase again into the high 80s to low 90s late week and into early next week.

Wind Direction (Fri):

Wind direction will blow generally from the 1B line to the 3B line until 12PM when the direction will become variable for the rest of the day.

Clouds:

Clouds will increase late week with the incoming rain chances, but skies will be clearer early next week.

Winds:

Sustained winds of 7 – 13 MPH throughout the week ahead with non-thunderstorm gusts of 15 - 20 MPH, but FRI PM and SAT AM could see gusts of over 30 MPH.
