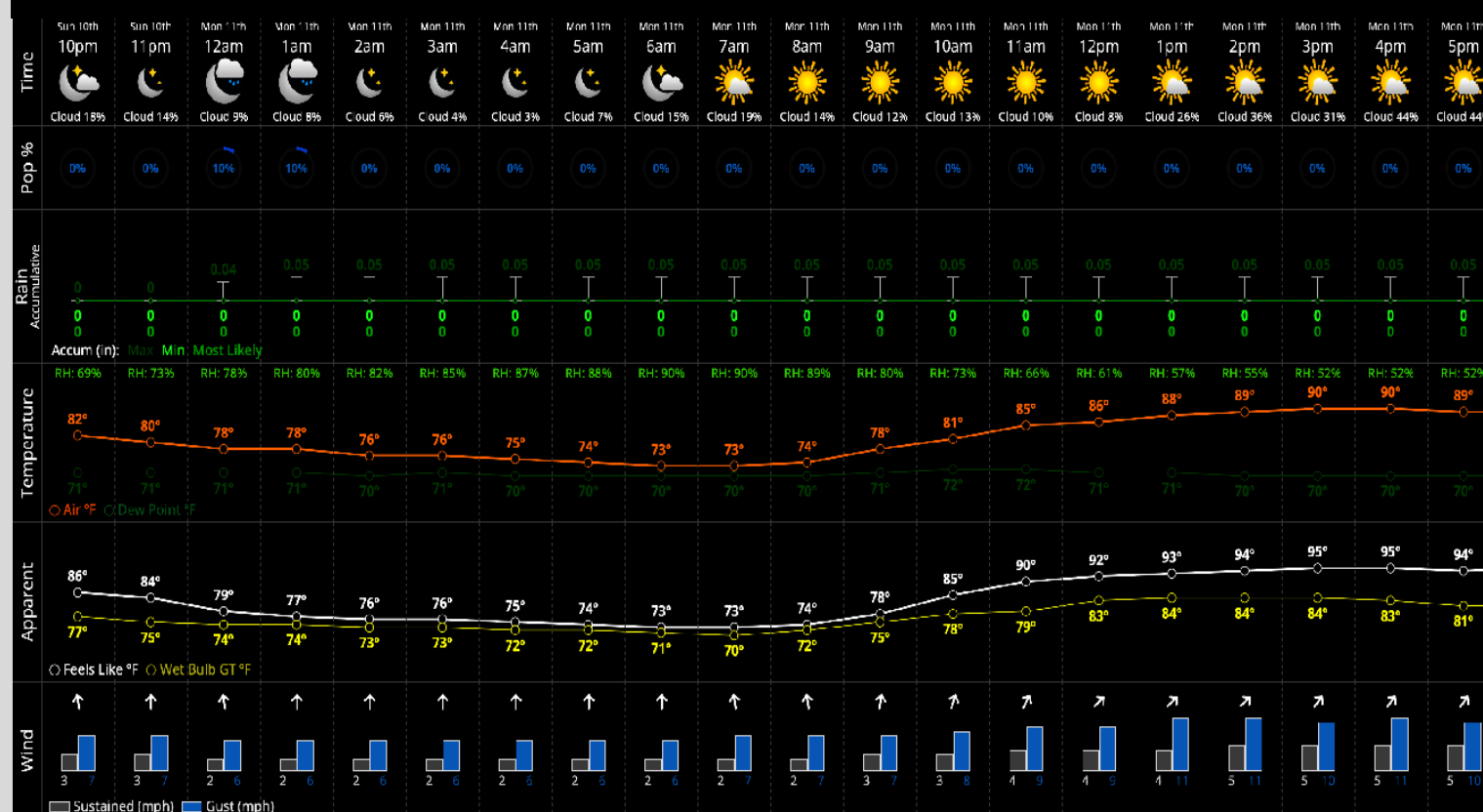

Sunday, August 10, 2025: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES

Precipitation:

- ✓ Isolated pop-up rain chances (~10%) will linger in the area through 10 PM, with mostly dry time favored.
- ✓ While a low-end lightning risk is possible, the better risk SUN PM will remain to the East.
- ✓ Additional isolated pop-up rain chances in play MON PM from 2-9 PM. Lightning is a low-end risk once again, with better risk to the North.

Temperatures:

- ✓ Low temps Monday AM will drop into the low 70s F.
- ✓ High temperatures Monday will reach the low 90s F by 3 PM.
- ✓ Heat indices will look to be in the 92-94 F range between 12 - 7 PM.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Favoring winds to be out of the S through 9 AM before shifting out of the SW.
- ✓ Winds will be generally calm at 3-8 MPH throughout Monday. Wind gusts will reach 6 - 11 MPH throughout Monday.
- ✓ Scattered clouds expected through 2 PM before skies become mostly overcast into the rest of the PM.

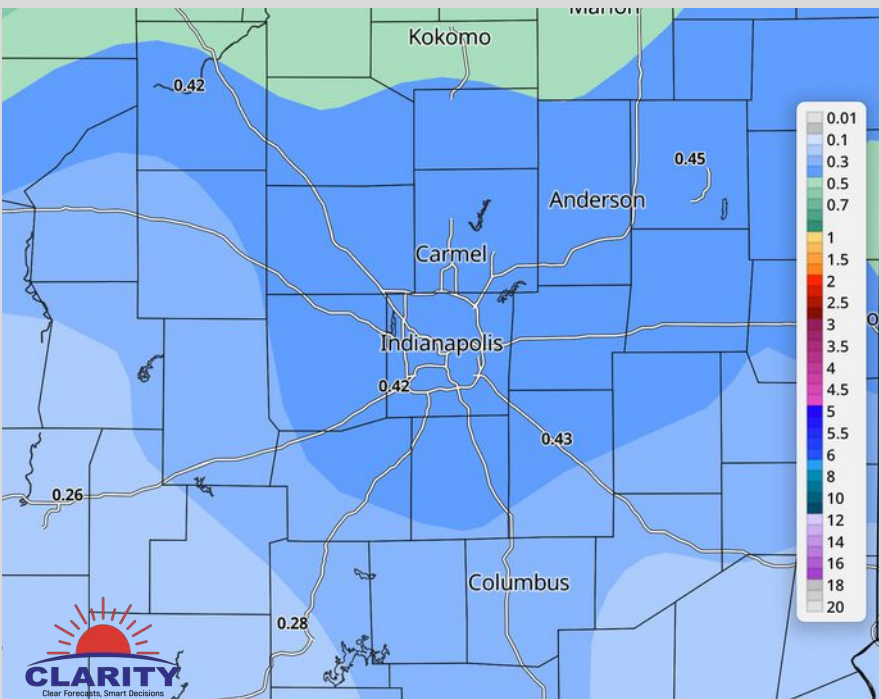

NEXT 5 DAYS: IMPORTANT FORECAST NOTES

Precipitation:

- ✓ **TUE:** Isolated pop-up risk possible from 2PM – 8PM (mostly dry time is favored). Lightning will be a low-end risk.
- ✓ **Late TUE PM-WED:** Monitoring for a more defined system to bring increased chances of scattered storms. Increased coverage of rain/storms will begin late TUE evening and last throughout WED.
- ✓ **THU-SAT:** Isolated pop-up risks once again possible from ~2PM – 8PM.

Temperatures:

- ✓ **TUE:** High temps will reach near 90 – 92 F with feels like temps of near 93 – 95 F.
- ✓ **WED-FRI:** High temperatures will look to sit in the upper 80s/near 90 F with feels like temps in the 91 – 93 F range.
- ✓ **SAT:** High temps will reach the low 90s F with feels like temps in the 93 – 95 range.

Wind/Clouds:

- ✓ Scattered clouds will be likely through TUE before more overcast skies are favored WED-THU.
- ✓ Sustained winds will generally be calm with a tendency to blow out of the South through TUE AM before shifting to more so to out of the West. Winds will likely be variable in direction THU-FRI.
- ✓ TUE – WED can feature occasional wind gusts near 15 – 20 MPH.
