





Wave heights are anticipated to dip below 6' by 7 PM SAT.


Wave heights of 4 – 5' are anticipated to persist through Sunday.

Houston Pilots Tropical Update










Tropical Storm Melissa has formed in the Caribbean. Melissa is favored to impact Cuba before turning out into the Atlantic.

No impacts are expected in Houston.

KEY NOTES

- Tropical Storm Melissa is expected to SLOWLY move westward this week and near Jamaica early next week - likely as a major hurricane (large track spread remains, however).
- The trend has been west closer to the Bahamas, but the threat for a US landfall remains very low. The SE Florida coast should at least monitor for elevated waves if the west track verifies.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Isolated to scattered thunderstorms anticipated between 1:00p through remainder of day and overnight. Coverage decreasing to very isolated after 11:00p CDT.

Wind: Winds will be out of the E/SE. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 4 – 9 kts, through day / night, increasing to 9 – 13 kt between 3p – 7p as storms pass. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 8 – 13 kts, increasing to 14 – 19 kts after 5PM. Wind gusts up to 20 kts will be possible after 5PM. Storms can produce gusts to 30+ kts.





Precip: Isolated storms through morning, becoming more scattered in nature after 12:00p CDT.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SE Friday. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 4 – 7 kts through noon, increasing to 10–15 kts through 10:00p. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 9 – 14 kts, increasing to 14 –18 kts after 4:00p. Winds at the boarding station can reach 20 kts. Non-thunderstorm wind gusts up to 23 kts will be possible for all stations Friday, with boarding station gusts to 27 kts. Storms can produce gusts to 30+ kts.




Forecast Discussion

Precip: Isolated to scattered thunderstorms from midnight onwards, increasing in coverage to widespread in nature around 6AM – 8AM. Storms will be capable of severe winds (40 – 50 kts) and hail. Isolated activity from 8AM-1P, before more scattered storms arrive. Additional scattered storms will be likely between 2PM and 10PM the rest of Saturday.


Wind: Winds will be out of the SE through 6AM before transitioning out of the S. N of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 7 – 12 kts. S of Morgan's Point: Winds will be at 15 – 20 kts through 5AM, calming to 10 – 15 kts through 9AM, then increasing again to 15-20 kts from 9AM to 12PM. Winds will be variable in the afternoon, with on-ff periods of 5 - 10 kts and 10 – 20 kts. Winds calming to 3-8 kts after 6PM. Non-thunderstorm wind gusts up to 30 kts will be in the forecast for ALL stations through 6PM.
