







- Patchy non-sea fog will be possible for stations S of Morgan's Point from 2AM 7AM on Saturday. Fog will likely remain N of the Boarding Station.
- Locations in the bay can expect visibilities to fall < 1 mi, with some areas able to see < ½ mi between 5 AM - 7 AM before storms arrive.
- The exact timing of fog dissipation remains a lowerconfidence forecast as storms approach in the early morning hours.


Precip: Scattered thunderstorms between 7:00a – 10:00a CST Saturday morning, clearing after 10:00a. Lightning and a few gusts to 30 kts will be in play as storms pass.

Wind: Winds out of the south until storms arrive at 7 AM. Winds predominantly out of the north after storms exit around 10 AM. N of Morgan's Point: Winds of 3 – 8 kts through the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds of 3-8 kts through 1 PM, increasing to 5 – 10 kts until 7 PM, then finally increasing to 10 - 15 kts through 12 AM SUN. Wind gusts of 10 – 15 kts through the day, increasing to 16 - 21 kts after 7 PM.






Precip: Dry conditions favored.

Wind: Winds out of the northeast through 2 PM, then out of the east for the rest of day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds of 3 - 8 kts through the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds 16 - 21 kts from midnight through 12 PM noon, falling to 4 - 9 kts through 7 PM, increasing again to 11 - 16 kts through 12 AM MON. Gusts of 15 - 20 kts through 9 AM, falling to 7 -12 kts through 1 PM, then calming through 7 PM before increasing again to 15 - 20 kts through 12 AM MON





Precip: Isolated thundershowers beginning around 9:00a CST, becoming more widespread in the evening between 6:00p CST MON – 12:00a CST TUES.


Lightning and gusts to 30+ kts are primary hazards.

Wind: Winds out of the southeast through 7 AM, then out of the south for the remainder of the day. N of Morgan's Point: Winds of 5 – 10 kts through 9 AM, increasing to 9 – 14 kts through 5 PM before calming back to 5 – 10 kts for the rest of the day. S of Morgan's Point: Winds of 11 – 16 kts through 7 AM, increasing to 13 – 18 kts through 4 PM, and calming back to 10 – 15 kts through 9 PM. Winds to spike as storms arrive Monday night. Gusts of 21-26 kts, especially NORTH of Morgan's Point, anticipated after 11 AM.


